Environmental Greetings!

This pertains to your Forest Land Use Agreement for Tourism (FLAgT) purposes covering an area of 4.9300 hectares of forest land located at Cagdanao Island, Barangay Casian, Taytay, Palawan.

Based on records, the said FLAGT was issued to Last Escape Development Corporation on February 9, 2010 under control number FLAgT No. 03-2010 (Bathing Establishment). Pursuant to Section 16 of DENR Administrative Order No. 2004-28, and the terms and conditions of FLAgT Contract Agreement, the holder shall pay an Annual Government Share amounting Php 110,925.00. Upon re-evaluation of the regional office based on DAO No. 2021-02, your new annual government shares effective last March 21, 2021 is Php 1,479,000.00.

Please be informed that based on records of this office, there is no payment of your Annual Government Share since the FLAgT was approved. In view of this, this serves as our DEMAND LETTER for compliance with your obligation to the government as a mutual agreement in the use of forestlands. Failure to do so is subject to suspension or cancellation of FLAgT as stipulated in Section 17 of DENR Administrative Order No. 2004-28 also known as Rules and Regulations Governing the Use of Forestlands for Tourism Purposes.
