FORESTLAND MANAGEMENT PROJECT

FMP is a ten-year Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) – Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) project that aims to strengthen forestland management in three critical river basins through the implementation of collaborative and comprehensive Community-Based Forest Management (CBFM) strategies.

The project aims to (1) rehabilitate degraded forestlands in three (3) critical river basins (Upper Magat & Cagayan, Upper Pampanga and Jalaur); (2) improve forest conservation and socio-economic conditions of affected communities; (3) contribute to disaster risk mitigation efforts in vulnerable areas; and (4) strengthen forestland management through community-based management strategies through: (a) empowering people's organizations, (b) securing land tenure rights, (c) enterprise development for food security and income, (d) development, conservation, protection and sustainable use of forestland resources

In order to address the decline of the forest resources and to minimize the negative impacts related to poor forest management, as well as to respond to the needs of upland communities, policy reform has been instituted in the country which resulted in the issuance of several innovative policy instruments during the 1990s. Forest policy has pursued a decentralized forest land management and partial devolution of forest management tasks and environment-related functions to the local government units (LGUs) and encouraged peoplecentered sustainable forest development.

COMMUNITY-BASED FOREST AND MANGROVE MANAGEMENT PROJECT

CBFMMP contributed to the improvement of environmental conditions and reduction of poverty in Panay and Negros by enabling participating people's organizations (POs) to manage forests and mangroves sustainably, adopt sustainable and productive upland farming systems, improve food security and living conditions, and improve access to market.

The Forest and Climate Protection Project in Panay has achieved its goal of protecting the globally significant biodiversity of the last large forest block of the Panay Mountain Range (PMR) and the sustainable and climate-friendly management of natural resources by local communities. Improved forest protection measures in the context of forest land use planning and its implementation,

the establishment of environmental offices in LGUs, the recruitment of local forest guards and the creation of alternative sources of income (agroforestry, agriculture, use of biomass as an energy source) for

illegal forest use have contributed to a significant reduction in deforestation in the PMR and the conservation of biodiversity.

ForClim is funded by the German Federal Ministry for the Environment and was implemented at the national level (DENR) and in 23 local government units (LGUs) in Panay Island.
