Please be informed that Ms. Ventura is requesting for a temporary transfer of her assignment from CENRO-Coron, Palawan to PENR Office, Puerto Princesa City due to her pregnancy. Her expected delivery is on January 08, 2023.

Be informed also that Ms. Venura is now on her 27 weeks and 4 days of pregnancy and planning to give birth in Puerto Princesa City since traveling from Coron to Culion during the month of November and December are very hard caused by Northeast Monsoon (*Amihan*). Likewise, the allowed weeks for a traveling pregnant mother via aircraft is at 35 weeks and below accompanied by personal physician and she will be at 33 weeks and 2 days by November 15, 2022.

Further, she is also willing to assist in accomplishing the target of the Regulation and Permitting Section (RPS) for the remaining period from November 15 to December 31, 2022, particularly on the completion of processing of the pending Public Land Applications (PLAs) as stipulated in her IPCR and employees commitment sheet submitted.


Likewise, the medical situation here in Coron is not as good as in Puerto Princesa City.
