



• 3RD QUARTER WATERBIRDS MONITORING

-The 3rd Quarter Waterbirds Monitoring was conducted by Snake Island personnel in partnership with City ENRO and CENRO Puerto Princesa City at Snake Island NCMCR on August 5, 2022. A total of forteen (14) species of birds were observed during the assessment, eleven (11) of which were waterbird species with a total of forty-six (46) individuals recorded and three (3) forest bird species with a total of nine (9) individuals counted.










Figure 1: Five main fishing activities identified in the island for the month of July to September 2022 with Gleaning as the fishing activity with the highest number of fisherfolks, followed by Crab Gill Net, Bottom Set Gill Net, Gill Net for Squid and Hook and Line with the lowest number of fisherfolks involved.




Figure 2: Seven (7) identified barangays that benefited on marine resources of Snake Island were recorded for the 3rd quarter of CY 2022, namely: Barangay Tagburos with the highest number of fisherfolks recorded followed by Barangay Manalo, San Jose, Sta. Lourdes, Maruyugon, Salvacion and Barangay Bacungan.




Figure 2: Total number of marine debris collected for the month of July to September 2022 with September as the month with the highest number of collection and August as the month with the lowest number of collection. The marine debris with the highest number of collection were plastics followed by residuals and special wastes.




Figure 3: Top three species of sea shells collected by gleaners from July to September 2022: Strombus (Canarium) urceus or "sikad sikad", Anadara antiquata or "bakalan" and Laevistrombus canarium or "ranga-ranga"

Gasoline consumed for the 2nd Quarter of CY 2022 for the official use of Speedboat with a total 744 liters of gasoline consumed.




Figure 4: Graph showing the month of September 2022 as the month with the highest amount of gasoline consumed and July with the lowest amount of gasoline consumed




