Dear Cenro Caluya,

We would like to thank you again for your team assistance in the EDC BINHI program for the rediscovery of our priority island endemic and critically endangered species in Narra, Palawan. We want to extend our thanks to Forester Ervin Valeriano for the proper guidance during our field work last October 7, 2022. Our primary purpose is to rediscover 2 species which can be found in 2 areas in Narra Palawan according to last herbarium records in 1984 (Diospyros transita in Trident Mining area) and in 1991 (Embolanthera spicata along Estrella falls). We still found Embolanthera spicata locally called Paningit along with our target priority species in brookes point the Barringtonia risdalei locally called Karakauat. We did not continue field survey within the Trident Mining areas due to time constraints but fortunately we also found *Diospyros transita* (Locally called Baris) in Brookes point palawan along Maasin river.

We documented 5 trees of Paningit, 7 trees of Karakauat in Estrella Falls, Narra, Palawan and 3 Baris in Maasin River, Brookes Point. We are sharing the records, Photos, including the GPS Coordinates for future conservation efforts (click the link).

As of to date, out of 16 priority island endemic and critically endangered species in Palawan we already documented 9. The remaining 7 can be found in areas of Mt. Thumbpeak, Iwahig, Mt. Victoria, Mt. Beaufort and 1 species in Busuanga Island. As requested also of your staff we are sharing the herbarium records of 16 priority species for potential rediscovery in your area.
