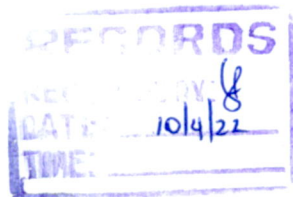
A total of 2411.75 kilos and additional 100 sacks (not weighed) of wastes were collected by 1,274 participants within 32 kilometers of coastal area.

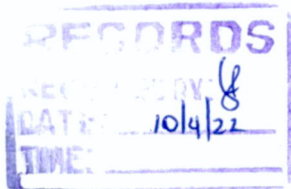
Respectfully submitted is the report from Forest Technician II/ Information Officer Aina Krizia S. Viray regarding the above-mentioned subject.

**REPORT OF THE INTERNATIONAL COASTAL CLEAN-UP DAY CELEBRATION  
AT THE MUNICIPALITIES WITHIN SAMARICA  
(SAN JOSE, MAGSAYSAY, RIZAL AND CALINTAAN)**

In the celebration of the International Coastal Clean-Up Day with the theme, *“Fighting for Trash Free Seas – Pilipinas: Ending the Flow of Trash at the Source”*, DENR CENRO San Jose spearheaded the coastal clean-up drive within municipalities of San Jose, Magsaysay, Rizal and Calintaan (SAMARICA), Occidental Mindoro on September 16 and 17, 2022.

This Office’s objective is to encourage involvement of all the above-cited municipalities in the celebration uprising their awareness and acceptance of their responsibility in addressing the improper solid wastes disposal issues especially within their coastal areas and bodies of water.
