I. SITUATIONAL OVERVIEW

At 3:00 PM today, the center of the eye of Typhoon "KARDING" {NORU} was estimated based on all available data at 400 km West of Dagupan City, Pangasinan (15.9°N, 116.6°E) with maximum sustained winds of 140 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 170 km/h. It is moving West at 30 km/h. Southwest Monsoon affecting the western sections of Southern Luzon and Visayas.

Forecast Weather Condition

Palawan will experience Monsoon rains caused by Southwest Monsoon / Trough of TY Karding. Metro Manila, Pangasinan, Zambales, Bataan, Cavite, Batangas, Aurora, Quezon, Occ. Mindoro, and W. Visayas will be cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and thunderstorms caused by SW Monsoon / Trough of TY Karding. The rest of the country will be partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms caused by SW Monsoon / Localized Thunderstorms.

Forecast Wind and Coastal Water Condition

Moderate to Strong winds from Southwest to South will prevail over the western section of Luzon. Coastal waters will be Moderate to Rough (2.5-4.0m)

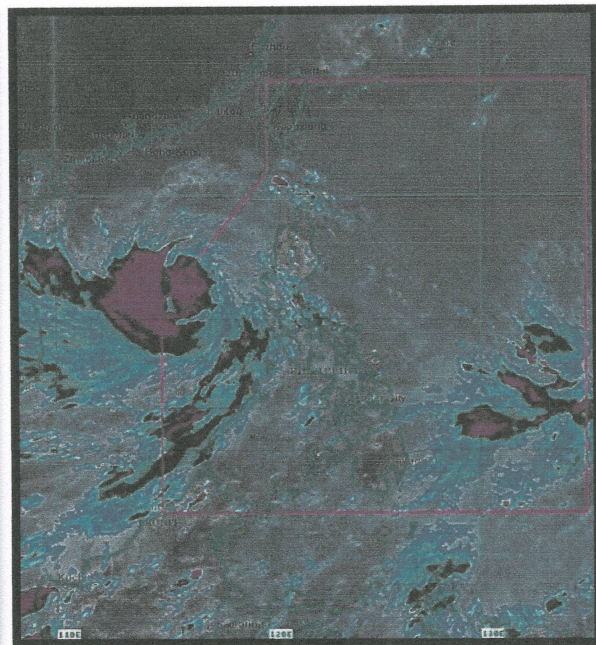
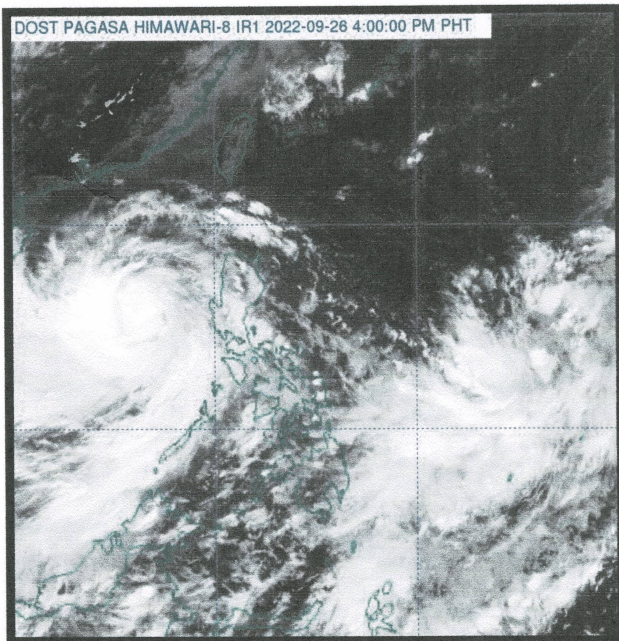

Face to face meeting, ZOOM App virtual Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and Facebook Messenger App for matters needed to be discussed and decided upon, as well as, sharing of data and information on the ground, coordination of actions of the CDRRMC members, Barangays and partners and matters relating to safety, preparedness and response.

4. The CDRRMC Chairperson through the EOC Manager may call anytime for CDRRMC member agencies to render duty at the PPC EOC located at City Coliseum.

In relation to the above, All BARANGAYS are directed to enjoin the following actions:

1. Activate Barangay DRRMCs Emergency Operations Center for early warning measures and vigilant monitoring of areas with settlements at the base of sliding slopes or ridges with manifestations of rockslide/landslide, tension cracks, and areas identified as very high/critical landslide zones.
2. Vigilant monitoring and reporting of weather disturbances and other incidents;
3. Continuously inform and advise all communities through all possible means regarding situation updates and preparedness actions of the localities;
4. Intensify the use of social media platforms for public information;
5. Monitor with vigilance the level of river waters and settlements in low-lying areas such as ricefields or near riverbanks which have experienced recent and repeated flooding;
6. Vigilant monitoring for possible riverbank erosion and shift of river flow direction;
7. Monitor, and prepare the necessary critical preparedness actions for the possible overflow of dams and sudden release of water that may affect the communities;
8. Conduct preventive measures such as trimming of trees, cleaning of culvert, floodways and drainages of debris, docking/safekeeping of fishing boats and others;
9. Ensure separate Evacuation center for COVID19 close contacts, confirmed individuals and

evacuees due to effects of natural calamities:

10. Ensure food and non-food stockpiles are available for evacuees/affected families;
11. Ensure that physical distancing is always observed in the evacuation centers;
12. Ensure the availability of sanitation stations in the evacuation centers;
13. Ensure that clean beddings and running water, hand soaps, trash bins are always available in the designated Evacuation Centers;
14. Constantly remind evacuees to always properly wear their face masks, even inside evacuation centers;
15. Ensure the availability of 70% ethyl or isopropyl alcohol and hand sanitizers;
16. Ensure that emergency response personnel are prepositioned in evacuation center/s;
17. Ensure that evacuation centers are properly and regularly disinfected;
18. Ensure that communication lines are working properly;
19. Monitor closely the recreational activities in the AQH, if situation is forecasted to worsen based on data and or due to upgraded alert level status, restrict activities such as, but not limited to, mountaineering, hiking, surfing, diving, swimming, etc.;
20. In case a gale warning has been issued, enforce a No-Fishing Policy and ensure that sea travel and small-scale fishing activities are closely monitored and prohibited;
21. If situation warrants, for safety of everyone especially to identified families situated in highly exposed and vulnerable areas (areas with high to very high susceptibility to storm surge, floods and landslides, especially residents whose dwellings are susceptible to damage due to strong winds) are strongly advised to implement PRE-EMPTIVE EVACUATION;

SEA TRAVEL ADVISORY

This is in reference to Weather Forecast issued by the **PAG-ASA** as of 4:00 PM today, 24 September 2022, wherein the center of Severe Tropical Storm **"KARDING"** was estimated at 505 km East of Casiguran, Aurora (15.7°N, 126.8°E) with maximum sustained winds of 110 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 135 km/h. It is moving West Southwestward at 25 km/h.

Likewise, Thunderstorm Advisory No. 9 Issued by #VIS_PRSD, Busuanga Radar as of 02:03 PM today, Moderate to heavy rain showers with lightning and strong winds due to thunderstorms are affecting over **#Palawan (Cuyo, Magsaysay, San Vicente, Coron, portion of Culion, Linapacan, El Nido, Taytay, Dumaran, Roxas and Araceli)**, which may persist 1 to 2 hours and may affect nearby areas.

In this connection, Coast Guard Station Puerto Princesa is temporarily suspending voyages of all vessels/watercrafts below 250 GT enroute at the abovementioned areas. However, said trips may resume their normal operation anytime if weather permits as declared by PAGASA.

Moreover, small watercrafts are advice not to venture at sea during unfavorable weather and sea conditions.

In view of the classification by the Regional Disaster Risk and Reduction Management Council (RDRMRC) MIMAROPA, placing the City of Puerto Princesa under Emergency Preparedness and Response (EPR) Protocol CHARLIE with High Risk Description, due to Super Typhoon "Karding", classes in public and private schools in all levels, and work in all government offices in the City, are hereby **suspended**, effective tomorrow, **26 September 2022 (Monday)**.

Government frontline services such as the City Health Office (CHO), City Disaster Risk and Reduction Management Office, (CDRRMO), City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO), KAAC, Solid Waste Management Office (SWMO), City Anti-Crime Task Force, City Traffic Management Office (CTMO), and those offices whose functions involve delivery of basic and health services, preparedness/response to disasters and calamities, and/or the performance of other vital services are exempt from this work suspension and shall continue to render the necessary services.

Suspension of work in private offices is left to the discretion of their respective management.

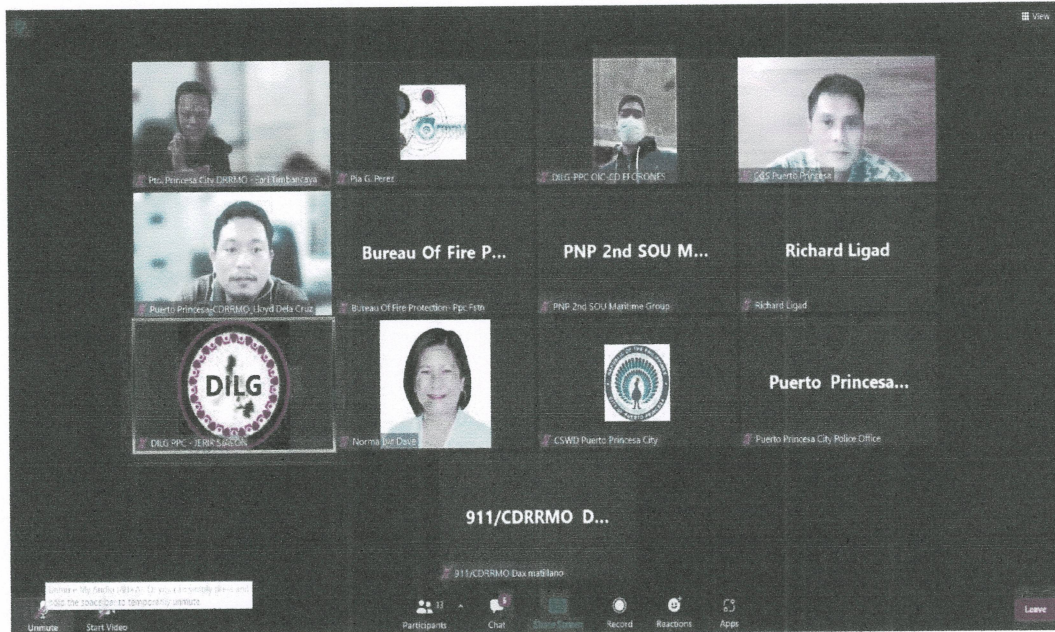
