Respectfully submitted is the report on the inspection and monitoring conducted on August 26,2022 of the CBFM-CARP project CY-2022 of Bantoto-Abaroan Farmers Multipurpose Cooperative (BAFARMAI) The project is entitled as Agroforestry Plantation and a combination of fruit trees and vegetables with Lagundi Honey Production.

During monitoring, the PO already established their nursery, and produced one thousand (1,000) Suha, Calamansi, Langka, seedlings of fruit trees one thousand (1,000) suckers for abaca and five hundred (500) seedling and wildlings of Mahogany.

However, it was observed that the PO of CBFM-CARP of Bantoto - Abaroan Farmers Association not yet received mobilization fund, hence, did not start yet for the site preparation activities like strip brushing instead to their priority work for daily survival of their family basic needs.

As a MEO assigned, below are the assistance to PO and recommendation, to wit:

ASSISTANCE:

- 1. Purchased additional Polybags for additional seedlings production while the PO is still waiting for the download of mobilization fund;
- 2. Assisted in arrangement of polybags containing media in nursery bed;
- 3. Help them collect Mahogany wildlings to fast-track the completion seedlings based on WFP since no one will take the initiative to collect because there is no fund yet;
- 4. Assisted them in putting the harvested wildings into the potting bags and arranging it in the nursery area, and
- 5. Help them set up the seedling in the nursery and organize it also helps in watering the seedlings.

RECOMMENDATION:

- That the PO counterpart re: hardening-off, needed by seedlings to adapt to adverse condition in the planting sites;
- 2. That the PO must transfer the Abaca to the planting site for an initial accomplishment while waiting for the mobilization fund;
- 3. Since they don't have fund for working and I am willing to help for moving to the planting area together with the CBFM Staff, and
- 4. Invite other PO members to be beneficiaries of CARP Project for 2022 and for the additional required number of seedlings to be produced.

With the above, the undersigned MEO will continuously monitor and supervise the project activities to ascertain the completion of the project.

PO's of MCBFCMA are continuous, conducting strip brushing and site preparation for the upcoming transplanting of the Bamboo plantation and also continues strip brushing for forest trees site. The POs already transplanted for 1,000 mahogany seedlings and also the 1,000 seedlings of Ipil ipil and with equivalent area of 2 hectares area planted as part of PO's counterpart and also, they have 0.5 hectare strip brushed for Agri-Silvi Crop planting area, and already planted fifty (50) suckers of banana.

As MEO assigned in the monitoring, below are the recommendation, to wit:

- That the PO must continue planting for forest trees and also for Agri-Silvi Crop while waiting for their mobilization fund;
- That transplanting of Bamboo to the planting site, since most of its were ready for replanting; and
- 3. That the PO must transplant, the bamboo forest trees, and also for Agri-Silvi Crop as soonest possible for their accomplishment.

With the above, the undersigned MEO will continuously monitor and supervise the project activities to ascertain the complementation of the project.
