: PUBLIC LAND APPLICATIONS COVERING RESULTANT

LOTS OF SUBDIVISION SURVEYS IN ROXAS, PALAWAN

DATE

: 27 September 2022

The PENRO Team's visit late last week, disclosed that respective bundle both of agricultural and residential free patent applications we have transmitted were put on hold on account of technical findings alleging tie line errors and manifesting doubts on the possibility of issuing double patents.

The fact that survey modules approved as Sgs. 04-002022-D, Sgs. 04-002112-D, and Sgs. 4B-000166-D affect if not entirely fall within the territory contested between the Municipalities of Roxas and San Vicente, does not prove that the foregoing segregation plans are not within Lot 7720 of Cad. 862-D in Bgy. Dumarao so as to conclude that tie lines of the resultant lots thereof are erroneous. The herein plotting thereof (Annex "A") over print of the corresponding cadastral map renders imperative the need to harmonize our reference maps if only to do away with findings not actually distinct but which may both accurately exist in cases of overlapping political boundary claims (Annex "B").

As to fears on the possibility of issuing double patents over residential lots in the Barangays of San Jose (Ccs. 04-000942), Tagumpay (Ts. 045318-000024), and Magara (Ccs. 04-001659 and Csd. 04-021055), herewith are certifications issued to the effect that the cadastral lots to which respective portions of the PLS lots subjected to the residential subdivisions are made equivalent to, actually are not covered by public land applications other than those filed involving resultant lots of the assailed residential subdivisions. This is in addition to the verification by no less than the Records Officer, appearing as indicated on the respective applications.

The exercise of due diligence along the Regional Office's instruction notwithstanding, it is hereby recommended that after affording the matter with its deserved review, especially of the fact that agricultural free patent applicants transact business before the Bgy. of Dumarao, corresponding patents be issued to the applicants, they having nothing to do with issues involved in politically contested territories and survey technicalities.

Catering to our target on patent processing and issuance (PPI) for the current fiscal year, we look forward to your considering the matter the soonest.

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
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


