2022 DENR MULTISTAKEHOLDER FORUM October 5-7, 2022 Diamond Hotel Manila

- 1. The DENR will conduct the 2022 DENR Multistakeholder Forum at Diamond Hotel Manila on October 5-7, 2022 to be participated by stakeholders from the Government, Academe, Private Sector and Development Sector/NGOs.
- 2. Officials are hereby instructed to follow the MANDATORY TRAVEL PROTOCOLS set by the national government and secure a negative test result for antigen at least twenty-four (24) hours before the event. Be reminded that antigen test may likewise be required on the 2nd and 3rd day of the forum. Same will be managed by the Administration and Logistics Committee c/o Director Rolando R. Castro.
- 3. Bring an electronic or printed copy of your vaccination card, which will be presented to the lobby guard of the hotel.
- 4. All DENR officials and participants are required to wear barong or business attire during the 3-day event.
- 5. All are requested to register each day at the designated Registration area before entering the Diamond Ballroom.
- 6. For hotel accommodation, earliest check-in time is on October 5, 2022 at 2:00 PM; latest check-out time is on October 7, 2022 at 12:00 Noon.
- 7. All officials are requested to fill-out the confirmation slip and send back the same to <u>hrds.personnek@denr.gov.ph</u>
- 8. Standby vehicles to be arranged by the Administration and Logistics Committee are available to convey the participants from DENR Central Office to Diamond Hotel Manila on October 5, 2022; the departure time is at 6:30 AM.
- 9. During the sessions, all must observe the minimum public health standards set by the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases, such as physical distancing and wearing of face masks.
- 10. Your respective drivers may drop you off at the venue and pick you up on the 3rd day of the event or you may opt to park in the following areas:
 - a) Basement, 8 hours of parking would cost P100.00(first come, first served basis)
 - b) Dolomite beach parking area
 - c) Other parking spaces identified by the Administration and Logistics Committee
- 11. Attendance at the forum is STRICTLY limited to Undersecretaries, Assistant Secretaries, Service, Program and Project Directors, Bureau Directors, Heads of Attached Agencies, Regional Executive Directors (REDs), identified stakeholders, and working committees.
