Respectfully submitted is the report of the BPRMO personnel pertaining to the data assessment of Lawin monitoring and patrolling activity of the FMB-BPR from January 2022 to date.

This is in reference to the meeting attended by the BPRMO personnel on August 12, 2022, via Zoom regarding the Rollout on the analysis of CY 2021 Lawin Data and 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter CY 2022 Assessment on the implementation of the Lawin Forest and Biodiversity protection System. It was facilitated by the Assistant Regional Director for Technical Services - MIMAROPA Region for the data managers, team leaders and Monitoring and Enforcement Section Chiefs of MIMAROPA and FMB held on August 12, 2022, 9:00 AM via Zoom.

The agenda discussed in the said meeting are the following: performance of field offices and patrollers; submission of summary table of manpower, and patrol data for update or deletion and other matters.

From the FMB Mr. Brian Lachica and Mr. Arnel Astrera discussed the "Quality Patrol" of the patrollers in the Lawin activity within their area of jurisdiction. They presented the sample on the proper evaluation of the duplicated patrols, GPS errors and patrols outside the conservation areas. They also gave examples of patrols for deletion if the number of waypoints/ observation did not match on the distance patrolled. It was also emphasize that the "Standard Patrol" for one (1) kilometer, there should be a minimum of ten (10) observations. The observations/ no. of waypoints could exceed the required number of waypoints but not less than, otherwise it will be subject for deletion. Moreover, the patrol should be within the declared Forest Conservation Area (FCA) in the area of jurisdiction, since some sample patrols presented that there are long distance patrolled but have few no. of waypoints or observations and the time travel was less than the standard patrol on foot. With this, the remarks will be for deletion and it seems that the patrollers were using motorcycle on the sample patrol. Likewise, the patrol should be within and indicated in the patrol plan submitted to the Region per Quarter.

It was point out that there are cases that the patrollers are conducting Lawin activity outside their corresponding Conservation Area and not indicated in the patrol plan.

In addition, during the meeting, the BPRMO personnel asked regarding the treatment of the Region Office on the accomplishment in Lawin monitoring and patrolling activity of FMB-BPR. It was clarified by one of the host of the meeting that the Lawin activity of FMB-BPR is counted and recorded by the Region, but the accomplishment report of the BPR was direct to the FMB.

Furthermore, for this data assessment of Lawin monitoring and patrolling activity of the FMB-BPR (attached file), as of June 2022 to present (August 2022), the BPRMO was able to record more than the required number of waypoints/observation. This is in reference to the travel report dated May 12, 2022 of the PDO, BPRMO, on the coordination with the PMEO/Focal of Lawin under Forest Resources Conservation Division-Forest Protection Section regarding the concerns of BPRMO in Lawin patrolling and monitoring system. The PDO, BPRMO was oriented regarding the standard protocols of Lawin (required number of patrollers, observations/ points per one (1) kilometer distance should not be less than ten (10) but can exceed more than 10 observations). Also, regular syncing of the Lawin system before importing new patrol should be practiced; updating/ uploading of actions taken by the BPRMO on the threats observed during Lawin patrolling and monitoring and the LAWIN Help Desk – other concerns of BPRMO on Lawin can be filled out on the website Lawin help desk.

For recommendation, the BPR Management Office is required to send the data assessment (excel file) of Lawin monitoring and patrolling in compliance to the said meeting.
