Background	The province is endowed with limited forest resources both in lowland and upland. It plays a vital role in providing forest goods and services which is crucial to human survival and perpetuation of wildlife resources. Forest cover in watershed areas in the province are facing dilemma due to anthropogenic activities. Upland and mangrove forests ecosystem are rapidly depleting due to illegal occupation, shifting cultivation, charcoal making, timber and wildlife poaching and illegal mining or quarrying. Some portions of mangrove swamps suffered from land conversion into fishponds and residential areas. Moreover, the effects of climate change are sound very alarming that were are now experiencing strong typhoons, floods, soil erosions and low harvest of agricultural products.		
	Due to these existing situations in our forest ecosystems, continuous conduct of intensified law enforcement by DENR-PENRO Marinduque and deputation of DENROs and WEOs, which are authorized representative from the PMFPC must be solicited.		
	As required under DAO 2008-22 entitled "REVISED GUIDELINES ON THE DEPUTATION OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES OFFICERS (ENROs)" it is the primary duty of the DENR to train and provide them with common frame of understanding and adequate knowledge on both technical and legal requirements before deploying them in the field as responsible DENROs.		
	Pursuant to Sec.13 of DAO 2004-55 S. 2004, DENR STREAMLINING/PROCEDURAL GUIDELINES PURSUANT TO THE JOINT DENR-DA-PCSD IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF RA NO. 9147 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "WILDLIFE RESOURCES CONSERVATION AND PROTECTION ACT" the DENR shall conduct orientation of Wildlife Enforcement Officer (WEO) prior to the assumption of duty to ensure that they will effectively perform their function.
