SEABIRDS CEPA DEVELOPMENT AND STAKEHOLDER

**ENGAGEMENT WORKSHOPS** 

During the 1<sup>st</sup> National Seabird Forum and Action Planning Workshop on 1-3 October 2021, gaps in seabird research and conservation in the Philippines were identified including the ways forward in fulfilling the Action Plan that was developed. To help achieve specific action plan objectives, the Biodiversity Management Bureau is organizing a Seabirds CEPA Development and Stakeholder Engagement Workshop on 25-26 April 2023 (held online via *Zoom*) and on 27-28 April 2023 (held hybrid at the Training Center, Ninoy Aquino Parks and Wildlife Center, Quezon City and via Zoom) for the CEPA Strategy Planning Workshop.

The primary goal of these workshops is to collaborate with and capacitate the local stakeholders and national agencies in developing a national CEPA strategy to help increase the awareness on seabirds among communities and national stakeholders. Three (3) of the five (5) thematic areas of the action plan: (i) research and monitoring; (ii) communications, education, public awareness (CEPA); and (iii) capacity building will be addressed in this workshop.

In line with this, we would like to request one (1) representative from the Conservation and Development Division, one (1) representative from the Regional Strategic Communication and Initiatives Group (RSCIG), and one (1) representative each from the marine protected areas, preferably those whose functions are aligned with CEPA to participate during the Stakeholder Engagement Workshop in the morning of 25 April 2023, and CEPA Strategy Planning Workshop the whole day on 27-28 April 2023.
