

Information, Education and Communication campaign and other activities are continuously conducted by the personnel of this office in collaboration and participation of the Local Government Units and other partner agencies and companies within the jurisdiction of the CENRO. Several activities from January to March 2023 were conducted and participated, to wit:

#### I. Special Events and Celebration

#### 1. National Zero Waste Month

Due to the recent flooding that happened in Brooke's Point, Palawan, CENRO Brooke's Point in collaboration with Coral Bay Nickel Corporation conducted IEC re: RA 9003 or the Ecological Solid Waste Management and facilitated the clean-up activity in waterways at Barangay District I, Brooke's Point, Palawan on January 27, 2023. There were 130 individuals (84 male and 46 female) consists of Local Government Unit, Purok leaders and local community of Barangay District I, MENRO Brooke's Point, Coral Bay Nickel Corporation, Rio Tuba Nickel Mining Corporation, Philippine National Police, PNP Maritime Group, Bureau of Jail Management and Penology, Bureau of Fire Protection, Philippine Coastguard and CENRO Brooke's Point personnel who participated the said activity. The activity started with a short program. EMB Embedded personnel Carl Anthony Madamag explained the purpose and importance of the activity. CENRO Leonard T. Caluya emphasized through his message that even if how small the things that we do for

the environment, when we do it together, it will create a big impact. Environment Monitoring Officer Ralph Noel Navarro discussed about RA 9003 or Ecological Solid Waste Management and reminders of proper waste segregation. The two mining companies also shared their best practices in Solid Waste Management. A total of 430 kilos of residual wastes, 150 kilos of recyclable materials, 120 kilos of glass/ bottles, 15 kilos of special wastes and 390 kilos of unsegregated wastes were collected in the area. It was collected by the garbage truck of MENRO Brooke's Point to be transferred to the Sanitary Landfill of the municipality.

#### 2. Tree Hugging Campaign

As part of the awareness raising efforts on the importance of nurturing forests and the benefits of tree to a person's well-being, CENRO Brooke's Point participated on the campaign entitled "Tree Hugging Campaign". On February 13- 17, 2023, a prescribed banner of the campaign was displayed on the Client's information television to mark the said celebration. On February 17, 2023, IEC Team together with Monitoring and Enforcement Section personnel proceeded to Sitio Bubog, Barangay Malis, Brooke's Point, Palawan. The Team hugged the Bubog Tree in the area. The tree has an approximate height of 18 meters and diameter of 220 centimeters and hugged by 14 people. Further, various indigenous tree species such as Narra, Dao, Amugis and Bintaog were simultaneously hugged by the personnel of Monitoring Stations. The activity was posted in Facebook as per instruction by the Forest Management Bureau. The campaign aims to promote social / health benefits that we can derive from nurturing forests/ trees, to raise awareness on the importance of tree hugging movement and to introduce an alternative way of celebrating Valentine's Day by showing and expressing the love and care for the environment through tree hugging.

#### 3. World Wildlife Day

On March 02, 2023, CENRO Brookes Point personnel guested on the environmental program of MENRO Bataraza: Ridge to Reef Connect to conduct IEC re: the celebration of World Wildlife Day. Information Officer Marie Kris Badilla discussed about the monthly celebration and the activities to be conducted in relation to the celebrations for the month of March. ECOMS I Mary Cris Ibañez tackled about the rich biodiversity and wildlife of Ursula Island Wildlife Sanctuary and Mount Mantalingahan Protected Landscape. She also discussed about the importance of wildlife. On March 03, 2023, through the collaboration of CENRO Brooke's Point and Coral Bay Nickel Corporation, an IEC and tree planting was successfully conducted at CBNC Bamboo Plantation for the celebration of World Wildlife Day. It was participated by Rio Tuba National High School Yes- O Club members, Supreme Student Government Officers and the Nickel Berg journalists. It started with a tree planting activity followed by an Information, Education and Communication campaign. Salient topics such as the History of World Wildlife Day, Rich Biodiversity and Wildlife in the Protected Areas, Importance of Forest, Wildlife and Chainsaw Act, Nicobar Pigeon as Flagship species of the

municipality of Bataraza and the Implementation of Solid Waste at Bataraza were discussed in the IEC. On the last part of the activity, the participants went to a nature walk at the CBNC Tailing Storage Facility 1: The rehabilitation program of CBNC, From Barren to Green. The participants were able to set their eyes on various species of trees, plants and flowers inside the facility.

#### 4. International Day of Forest

On March 21, 2023, through the invitation of Rio Tuba Nickel Mining Corporation, CENRO Brooke's Point personnel conducted IEC to the personnel of RTNMC for the celebration of International Day of Forest. It was participated by field personnel of RTNMC such as SCAA, GSSI Security Group, Forestry helper and Earth balling personnel. Topics such as Facts and Figures of DENR as well as the programs and services implemented in CENRO Brooke's Point and Forest Protection and Importance of Forest were discussed in the IEC. On the end of the program, 5 personnel were asked what will be their contribution in protecting the environment? The participants fondly answered the question emphasizing their contribution to help protect and conserve the natural resources and environment.

#### 5. World Water Day

On March 22, 2023, CENRO Brooke's Point facilitated the coastal clean-up at Sitio Buligay coastal areas, Barangay District I, Brooke's Point, Palawan for the celebration of World Water Day. The event was held together with 70 volunteers (37 female and 33 male) from LGU MENRO and MSWD, Philippine Coastguard and CENRO Brooke's Point personnel. A total of 36 sacks or 342.5 kilos consist of 200 kilos residual wastes, 70 kilos cans/bottles and 72.5 kilos unsegregated wastes were collected during clean-up. The wastes collected by the participants were transferred to the Municipal Sanitary Landfill by the LGU Solid Waste Management.

#### II. Forest Protection Awareness

The continuous coordination with the LGUs and IEC activities is conducted regularly to strengthen the relationship of all stakeholders and monitoring and manning of checkpoints 24/7 is being implemented. The IEC also increases awareness of the community on the importance of the forest and its benefits in their daily lives and the effects of forest destruction/denudation including the forestry laws, rules and regulations being implemented by the DENR in the protection and conservation of our natural resources.

On March 15, 2023 and March 22, 2023, Delisting Team of CENRO Brooke's Point proceeded to Barangay Igang- igang and Barangay Tarusan to coordinate the schedule of activities/ IEC for the delisting process of the Municipality of Bataraza. The team attended the Barangay Assembly and discussed brief information about the services and programs of DENR.
