1. INTRODUCTION

The proposed project is the dredging works along the lower reach of Mag-Asawang Tubig River in the Municipality of Naujan, Province of Oriental Mindoro. The project is to improve the conveyance capacity of the river to minimize flooding along the adjacent areas without cost to the government of the Republic of the Philippines.

As part of the public participation in the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) Report PEISS-based applications, a Public Scoping was undertaken. This Public Scoping documentation report summarizes the notification methods and comments received at the public scoping.

2. DATE AND VENUE / OBJECTIVES

Mag-Asawang Tubig River Restoration Project



- The impacts in these areas are considered secondary as these will only
 manifest after sufficient dredge material volume has been removed and
 effects of the flood management measure is observed at the lower
 sections of the river where storm drains tend to accumulate and spread
 when high tide prevents river discharge to the sea.

Further refinements on the delineation of the DIA and IIA will be made after (a) the continuing Stakeholder Consultation and the evaluations of (b) the EIA Management Division of the DENR and the Review Committee.
