Relative thereto, this Office would like to provide you of the zip file containing the shapefiles of Production and Protection Forest which can be accessed thru https://tinyurl.com/DHSUDRequest.

With regard to the dataset relative to land classification, this Office recommends that you coordinate directly with the National Mapping and Resource Information Authority (NAMRIA), as the central mapping agency, depository and distribution of natural resources data including map making services.

On the other hand, please be informed that the data /information on the NGP and application for Forestry Tenure instrument is being implemented and processed respectively by the concerned DENR Regional and Field offices, pursuant to DENR Administrative Order (DAO) No. 2022-10 entitled "Revised DENR Manual of Authorities on Technical Matters". Hence, we further suggest that you also coordinate with the said DENR offices for the updated (real time) data and information on NGP and tenurial instruments, the matter is within their area of concerns and jurisdictions.
