Warm Greetings from UPLB-CFNR!

The UPLB-CFNR is part of a regional alliance of four (4) countries implementing a regional research project entitled, "Strengthening collaborative tree seed supply systems for restoration in Asia" with Bioversity International (part of the Alliance Bioversity-CIAT) as the project leader. The project will work with forestry authorities, Forest Landscape Restoration (FLR) implementers, and forest-dependent communities in Bangladesh, India, Indonesia, and the Philippines to strengthen institutional and technical capacities so that FLR projects are linked with quality seed sources and local seed producers with customers to support local livelihoods and sustainable forest management. In the Philippines, UPLB-CFNR has partnered with ERDB FWRDEC in Mindanao to implement this project.
