I. Rationale

The Philippine Multi-Sectoral Nutrition Project aims to support the government in adopting a bold, multi-sectoral nutrition approach to deliver a coordinated package of nutrition-specific and nutrition-sensitive interventions across various LGUs together with a harmonized social behavior change and communication strategy. The project will prioritize LGUs with the highest burden of childhood stunting and project beneficiaries will comprise children under five years old and pregnant and lactating women. There are 14 identified target areas in the MIMAROPA region, this includes 7 municipalities in Occidental Mindoro and 7 municipalities in Romblon.

The project is expected to increase the availability of nutrition funds at the local level for program implementation through strengthening local-level planning and budgeting and ensuring that the nutrition challenges are addressed multi-sectoral. The project aims to boost the efficiency of resource use by better aligning local-level nutrition interventions with nutrition needs by encouraging the LGUs to focus on results by providing financial incentives at the local level to attain nutrition results. Lastly, the project will build on a community-based approach to mobilize the target communities and support critical behavioral change for improved nutrition outcomes.

To mark the commencement of the Philippine Multisectoral Nutrition Project Implementation, the Regional Project Management Office MIMAROPA will hold the Official Project Launch with the MPMOs and Ceremonial Signing of the Supplemental Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) on the afternoon of August 31, 2023.
