A TWO THOUSAND (2,000) HECTARES IN ABONGAN, TAYTAY,  
PALAWAN**

Respectfully submitting is the above subject per records in compliance to the phone call instruction yesterday and today by the CENR Office Pablo L. Cruz, to wit:

1. Tree Farm Lease Agreement 484 covers two thousand (2,000) hectares contiguous in Sitios Canduyog, Tula-tulahan, and Calabutuan of Abongan, Taytay, Palawan and has ended/terminated and ceased its operation since July 31, 2010.
2. The Corporation, through representation of Mr Jose S. Buenaobra filed an Application for its renewal on September 28, 2014 duly notarized and received in this Office.
3. The application for renewal is covered by clearances and endorsement as follows:
  - a. Certificate of Zoning Clearance by the Municipal (Taytay) Planning and Development Office
  - b. Endorsement for renewal per ECAN Board Resolution No. 23-2015.
  - c. Endorsement for renewal per Sangguniang Bayan Resolution No. 001-2015.
4. The TFLA is located within the Malampaya Sound Protected Land and Seascape (MSPLS), hence there is on record an undated report in Complete Staff Work Format rendered by then Chief of the Forest Management Services of this Office, Forester Constante B. Bose recommending the conversion of the Tree Farm Lease Agreement into a Special Land Use Permit which on areas within protected area is meant Special Agreement for Protected Area (SAPA).

5. The processing of Special Agreement for Protected Area is on suspension and the remedial thereof is the crafting of Memorandum of Agreement between the DENR and the stakeholder for which the records also show of the existence of PAMB Resolution No. 06, Series of 2016 as an endorsement of the crafted Memorandum of Agreement.
6. The Memorandum of Agreement is yet with this Office and the lacking requirement thereof are the final map of the TLFA area.

Consequent of above, the undersigned for the moment makes comment that Sangguniang Bayan Resolution No. 001-2015 dated January 5, 2015 cited as well to consider sentiments in certain Barangay (Abongan) Assembly Resolution No. 1, Series of 2014 opposing the renewal of the TLFA which indeed deserves final resolution being called out in said Sangguniang Bayan Resolution No. 001-2015 addressed to the Palawan Council for Sustainable Dvelopment (PCSD), Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), and Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) of Malamapaya Sound Protected Land and Seascapc.

Petisyon-Resolusyon), sa ginanap na Barangay Assembly Meeting, sa nabanggit na petsa sa itaas, at natanggap ng Tanggapan ng Mayor ng Municipality ng Taytay, Palawan noong ika-30 ng Nobyembre, 2010.

Na sa unang pagpapahayag ng aming pagtutol sa renewal ng Tree Farm Lease Agreement sa Normal Holdings Development Corporation (NHDC), ang LESSEE (Ref. TREE FARM LEASE AGREEMENT NO. 484) ay si G. JOSE CH. ALVAREZ, na sa kasalukuyan ay amin ng Minamahal na Gobernador ng Palawan.

At noong nagpahayag kami ng Bukas na Liham ng nasabi pa ring pagtutol, sa aming kasalukuyang Minamahal na Gobernador ng Palawan, HON. JOSE PEPITO C. ALVAREZ, na nagmamay-ari ng nasabing Corporation, sa renewal ng Tree Farm Lease Agreement (TLFA) o anumang instrument ng paggamit at pagpapahiram ng bahagi ng Watershed Area ng Barangay, sa Canaro, Calabatuan, Tulatulan at Panan-ayan na sakop ng Barangay Abongan, Taytay, Palawan, sa Normal Holdings Development Corporation (NHDC).

Kami ay tumututol sa kadahilanan na:

5. Ang pangunahing kabuhayan ng mga tao ay ang pagsasaka na pinagmumulan ng kanilang pagkain araw-araw, pampa-aral ng kanilang mga anak, gastusin araw-araw at perang iniipon sa panahon ng sakit at iba pang pangangailangan ng pamilya, na

6. Ang Watershed area ay kaisa-isang kasiguraduhan ng pangmatagalang pag-unlad ng pagsasaka na pinagmumulan ng tubig para sa mga basakan at pagpapalawak pa ng maraming Irrigation Projects sa kabila ng banta ng pabago-bagong klima;
7. May mga insidente ng mga illegal na pagputol at pagkuha ng malaking volume ng kahoy-gubat na nangyari sa nasasakupan ng Normal Holdings and Development Corporation at bahagi ng Abongan Watershed area na siya namang labag sa dating kasunduan ng Tree Farm Lease Agreement (TLFA);
8. Na nag-expire na ang dalawampu't limang taong (25) paggamit ng 2,000 hektaryang lupa ng NHDC noong July 31, 2010 na nagsimula noong June 29, 1984 at ang renewal nito ay tinutulan din ng isang Barangay Assembly noong November 15, 2010;

A NARRATIVE REPORT OF AN OCULAR INSPECTION CONDUCTED BY TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP IN THE TREE FARM LEASE AREA OF NORMAL HOLDINGS AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION ON JULY 18, 2014

This pertains to the output of a meeting conducted and attended by the Abongan Technical Working Group on July 11, 2014, organized by Barangay composed of the Barangay Officials PNNL, LGU Municipality, LGU Province, Religious Group, and the DENR-CENRO, Re-Normal Holding Development Corporation (NHDC) Application for renewal of their Tree Farm Lease agreement Requesting Abongan constituents and Barangay Officials to endorse NHDC Application for renewal of its lease and to continue its implementation. With this, the Technical working Group has agreed to a decision to conduct an ocular inspection of the area applied for renewal of the Tree Farm Lease by NHDC and whether the lessee has complied with the terms and condition stipulated in the contract or whether the permittee has violated certain Forestry Rules and Regulation in the protection preservation and development of the Forest Resources specially in the protection of watershed areas in Abongan, or whether the permittee has introduced specie which are beneficial to the Forest environment and to the community in terms of physical and economic development.

Result of ocular inspection conducted by the Technical Working Group within the area of Normal Holding Development Corporation on July 18, 2014, located in Sitio Canaro, Calabatuan, Candiuyog and junction of Odiong and Abongan Falls are the following to wit:

1. The Technical Working Group was able to reached the area inspected, verified and observed the real situation of the area by way of four wheeled, two (2) vehicles following plantation road, constructed by the Normal Holding and Development corporation.
2. Champada fruit trees which are already bearing were planted along the road going to the main camp in Canaro and Calabatuan.
3. Other fruit trees bearing seen in the area are marang, durian, lacatan, jackfruit, and Bangkok santol and none bearing fruit trees are lanzones, mangosteen and mango.
4. It was noticed that a portion of the area was also developed into a Riceland.
5. Aside from fruit trees, other forest specie planted and seen in the area are: Acacia Mangium, Albizzia Falcata, Philippine Mahogany, Gmelina arborea, and newly planted rubber trees.
6. Existing road going to the area was also observed including houses of the laborers and a storage (bodega) or packing house.
7. NHDC has also a 4 wheeled services vehicle for their use in their operation and doing emergency cases.
8. Proceeding further to the area particularly to the Abongan falls, we also noticed newly planted rubber and marang trees.

## Remarks and Recommendation:

As per inspection, verification, and observation conducted within the plantation site of Normal Holdings and Development Corporation (NHDC), the following are the fact, findings, and recommendation to wit:

1. NHDC has complied the terms and condition as stipulated in their contract especially in the planting of forest and fruit trees of high potential value which is the main motive and purpose of the leasee.
2. NHDC has previously constructed accessible road going to their plantation site in Canaro, Calabatuan, and Canduyog to serve as access to protection development and link to market.
3. NHDC has also acquired Riceland area within the plantation more or less five (5) hectares for their consumption of their plantation crew.
4. NHDC has also constructed bank houses for their plantation crew.
5. There was no clearing or cutting of Indigenous trees seen in the watershed areas of Abongan.
6. The drops of water and flow of Abongan Falls and river is abundant and the water is still clear and not polluted and is evident or good sign that the watershed area is not disturbed or damage.
7. No landslide and erosion is occurring in the area.
8. Sooner or later, the Tree Farm Lease of Normal Holding and Development Corporation will create a job opportunity to the people of Abongan and the fruit trees planted of high potential value is also beneficial to the health of the people.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, we the composite team as Technical Working group expresses our volition to say that NHDC committed no violation into their areas of responsibility and obligation, instead a beneficial development is exhibiting in the area for the welfare of the forest environment and to the people of Abongan and neighboring vicinities.











In compliance with your memorandum dated 03 August 2010 and PENRO Special Order Number 2010-022, please be informed that the joint validation team composed of PENRO and CENRO technical personnel conducted an actual assessment over the area applied for renewal of Tree Farm Lease Agreement owned by Normal Holding Development Corporation located at the above-mentioned barangay. The following findings were gathered and observed in the development of the area as established by the holder to wit:

**I. Background**

On JUNE 29, 1984 the then Minister Teodoro Q. Peña issued a Tree Farm Lease Agreement (TFLA) No. 484 to Normal Holding Development Corporation covering an area of 2,000 hectares located in Canaro, Abongan and Alcalian, Taytay, Palawan. The said agreement has a duration of twenty-five (25) years to expire on July 31, 2010 renewable for another twenty-five (25) years. The renewal of the agreement should be subjected for validation/assessment of the area to know if the holder has complied with the terms and conditions stipulated in the agreement.

Hence, the joint validation team composed of PENRO and CENRO personnel conducted an assessment and gathered the following findings.



## COMPLETE STAFF WORK (CSW)

### I. SUBJECT

Tree Farm Lease Agreement awarded to Normal Holding and Development Corporation located at Canaro, Abongan, and Alacalian, Taytay, Palawan.

### II. HISTORY AND CHRONOLOGY OF FACTS AND EVENTS

The awarded Tree Farm Lease Agreement is specifically located at  $119^{\circ}24'20.43''$  longitude and  $10^{\circ}39'53.47''$  latitude with an approximate horizontal distance of 21 kms from Poblacion proper of Taytay, Palawan. The subject area covers 2,000 hectares which falls within the timberland area, Block G, Project 9-O, LC 1614 September 23, 1952.

The NHDC is determining to engage in forest development/ reforestation activities using high valued crops. The following are the information as per record of this office to wit:

1. That on June 29, 1984 the then Minister Teodoro G. Peña issued a Tree Farm Lease Agreement (TFLA) No. 484 to Normal Holding Development Corporation covering an area of 2,000 hectares located at Canaro, Abongan, and Alacalian, Taytay, Palawan.
2. That the said agreement has duration of 25 years and the same was expired on June 29, 2009.
3. That on August 13, 2010 Foresters Constante B. Bose, Rogello L. Namoc, Elegio Adelantar, Forest Rangers Roldan Alvarez and Ronald Villadamosa submitted their report re: assessment/validation report on the environmental performance of Normal Holding Development Corporation holder of Tree Farm Lease Agreement No. 484 represented by Jose S. Buenabita located in Canaro, Abongan and Alacalian Taytay, Palawan (Annex A).

That based on the report submitted, it shows that the leasee has religiously complied with the terms and condition stipulated in the agreement, hence, the processing and approval of the renewable application of the Tree Farm Lease Agreement is hereby recommended.

4. That on December 15, 2010, the Interfaith Leaders Initiative for Territorial and Development (IF-LITED) represented by Rev. Father J. Y. Casbay, Pstr. Rover U. Mijares, Pstr. Dan Anat, Pstr. Henry Espadero, Pstr. Joyce Endrico, Mr. Fred Delumpines and Mr. Simplicio Quillio sent their letter dated December 15, 2010 together with the Petition-Resolution of the legal residents of Brgy. Abongan, Taytay, Palawan to His Excellency, President Benigno Aquino III simply desire that the watershed for Brgy. Abongan be defined, delineated and secured for the livelihood of their people, and not to grant a renewal of lease to Normal Holdings and Development Corporation.

### III. APPLICABLE LAWS/ISSUANCES

- Section 20, PD 705 – States that no person may utilize, exploit, occupy, possess or conduct any activity within any forest land and operate any wood processing plant unless he has been authorized to do so under a license agreement, license or permit.
- Section 37, PD 705 – All measures be taken to protect the forest resources from destruction, impairment and depletion.
- Section 51, PD 705 – Management of occupancy in forest lands.
- Section 57, PD 705 – other Special Uses of Forest Lands – forest lands maybe leased for a period of not exceeding twenty-five years renewable upon the expiration thereof for a similar period.
- Section 20, RA 7586 (NIPAS Act) – Occupation of timberland without tenorial instrument is strictly prohibited.
- Presidential Proclamation 342 dated July 12, 2000 – Declaring the Malampaya Sound situated in the municipalities of Taytay and San Vicente, Province of Palawan as a protected area pursuant to Republic Act 7586 (NIPAS Act of 1992) and shall be known as Malampaya Sound Protected Landscape and Seascape.
- DAO No. 17 series of 2007 – Rules and regulations governing special uses within protected areas.

### IV. JUSTIFICATION

1. That the lease started developing the area since January 1985. The said area was planted with the different types of fruit trees, forest trees and agricultural crops. Those trees that were planted are mango, durian and kalapi (palm). And those fruit trees are already productive.
2. That Rambutan and Champada were also planted along the road as vegetative measure to minimize the occurrence of landslide and soil erosion. Mangosteen and Lanzones were also planted within the forest tree area. Other forest tree species that were planted in the area are mangium, mahogany, tsengkei and falcate. Those trees had already reached its merchantable height.
3. That the lease holder also maintained their nursery to sustain the seedling requirements for planting activities.
4. That the holder constructed a structure made of light materials as shelter for their staff and laborers.
5. That based on record, the holder is regularly submitting their accomplishment report. It is stipulated that the protection measures implemented in the area includes clearing/removal of old debris and fire line construction, cutting affected branches/trees with pest and diseases and other forest protection activities to protect the lease area from any form of forest destruction.

6. The lease holder had also constructed an all weather road from Ibangley going to the main camp in Sitio Calabatuan and Sitio Canaro. An access road was also constructed going to area 3 and 4 in Sitio Canduyog. (Please see attached sketch map)
7. Attached herewith are pictures taken within the plantation of different fruit trees and forest trees in the area

V. RECOMMENDATION

In view of the above findings and considering that the lease has religiously complied with the terms and condition stipulated in the agreement and that the area is situated within Malampaya Sound Protected Landscape and Seascape, it is hereby recommended that the Tree Farm Lease Agreement should be converted into Special Use Agreement in Protected Area (SAPA) upon renewal of the holder.



Presidential Decree No. 472, as long as the main development of the area for tree farm purposes shall not be hampered and/or defeated.

II. The planting and raising of trees herein granted shall be confined within the expanse of public forest land described herein and no other parcel of public forest land shall be utilized by the herein LESSEE without first securing the permission of the LESSOR. The LESSEE shall conserve and preserve the monuments and other landmarks indicating corners and cutlines marking the boundaries of the area covered by this lease agreement.

III. The area leased herein is a public forest land to the best knowledge and belief of the contracting parties, and accordingly, the LESSOR shall not be responsible for any loss suffered by the LESSEE in case the land is declared private property of another person, or otherwise reduced, modified, amended and/or cancelled as a result of prior, existing valid private claims or interests therein.

IV. The LESSOR reserves the right to permit the opening, if public interest requires, of such portion of the area under lease to road right-of-way, which shall not be more than ten (10) meters wide; Provided that the person or entity granted the road right-of-way shall pay the LESSEE, a reasonable compensation for any damage to improvements, if any, occasioned by such opening.





the lease, except for causes beyond control, then this lease agreement may be cancelled by the LESSOR.

IX. The LESSEE shall improve and plant at least 20% of the area herein granted within three (3) years from the issuance of this lease agreement; 50% of the area within five (5) years, and the balance within ten (10) years, in accordance with the development plan approved by the LESSOR; Provided, However, That the LESSEE shall always maintain the areas aforesaid which shall be planted with trees immediately after that are cut, otherwise, the LESSOR may reduce the area granted commensurate with the capability of the LESSEE to improve and make use of the area, or cancel the lease and forfeit the bond deposit.





In the event of violation by the LESSEE or his authorized agents of any of the provisions of the Forest Laws, Forestry Administrative Order, or other laws and regulations or instructions now or thereafter in force, governing the protection of the planted forest or the area granted, or of the terms of this lease agreement; and in the event that after due warning by the LESSOR to the LESSEE, the latter fails within a reasonable time, which time shall not exceed three (3) months, to stop the violation referred to; or in the event the LESSEE or his agents or other persons operating under the lease agreement, commit an act tending to influence a forest Officer, to induce him directly or indirectly to violate existing rules and/or regulations, then this agreement may be cancelled by the LESSOR.

XVII. The LESSOR reserves the right to regulate the cutting or harvesting of the timber crops to insure constant forest cover of the area.

XVIII. The LESSEE is required to submit on or before the 30th day of January each year an annual report to the LESSOR showing, among others, the number of hectares planted during the year, the number planted by species, the number of survival at the end of the year by species; nurseries established (give number and dimensions of each); and seedlings raised introduced during the year. This report shall cover the period January 1 to December 31 every production year.

XIX. The LESSEE shall not impede, obstruct and in any manner prevent the permittee or licensee affected from entering or passing through the area in connection with his logging operations if any, by virtue of the lease herein granted, and vice-versa.

XX. In the process of development of the area, the LESSEE shall exercise precautionary measures to insure the protection of watershed values.


XXI. The LESSEE shall pay, in addition to regular rentals for the use of the land starting from the sixth year of his operation an additional fee equivalent to six percent (6%) of the forest charges on products gathered or harvested from the tree farm, or applicable charges as determined by the LESSOR.

XXII. Request for exemption from the payment of the percentage tax levied in title V of the National Internal Revenue Code when the timber and forest products are sold, bartered or exchanged by the LESSEE, whether in their original state or not shall properly be coursed thru the LESSOR for action and indorsement to proper authorities.



- a. Amount expended by the LESSEE in the development of the tree farm prior to the time when the production state in which, may, at the option of the LESSOR, be regarded as ordinary and necessary business expenses or as capital expenditures; and





XXIX. In the event that there are old growth forest, mossy forest and other prohibited portions within the area subject of this lease agreement which may be discovered -later the same shall be subjected to ground delimitation within sixty (60) days after discovery.

XXX. In the event that there shall be found later forest occupants within the area subject of this lease which were already there before inspection of the area was made, the LESSEE shall within sixty (60) days upon discovery of such occupants, submit a revised tree farm development plan to conform with the reduced area which plan shall include, among others, an effective scheme for the management of such forest occupants consistent with the provisions of PD 705, as amended, and other policies, rules, and regulations related thereto. If such occupants were proven to have been in the area before 19 May 1975, the LESSEE shall not disturb the occupancy until further instruction from the Director of Forest Development, and priority shall be given to these forest occupants in the matter of employment.

XXXI. Construction of permanent infrastructure that are not necessary in the development of the tree farm such as houses of concrete and strong materials is not allowed under this lease.

XXXII. The LESSEE shall coordinate/link-up his development scheme with the "Kilusang Kabuhayan at Kaunlaran (KKK)" program of the New Republic.



A NARRATIVE REPORT OF AN OCULAR INSPECTION CONDUCTED BY TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP IN THE TREE FARM LEASE AREA OF NORMAL HOLDINGS AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION ON JULY 18, 2014

This pertains to the output of a meeting conducted and attended by the Abongan Technical Working Group on July 11, 2014, organized by Barangay composed of the Barangay Officials PNNL, LGU Municipality, LGU Province, Religious Group, and the DENR-CENRO, Re-Normal Holding Development Corporation (NHDC) Application for renewal of their Tree Farm Lease agreement Requesting Abongan constituents and Barangay Officials to endorse NHDC Application for renewal of its lease and to continue its implementation. With this, the Technical working Group has agreed to a decision to conduct an ocular inspection of the area applied for renewal of the Tree Farm Lease by NHDC and whether the lessee has complied with the terms and condition stipulated in the contract or whether the permittee has violated certain Forestry Rules and Regulation in the protection preservation and development of the Forest Resources specially in the protection of watershed areas in Abongan, or whether the permittee has introduced specie which are beneficial to the Forest environment and to the community in terms of physical and economic development.

Result of ocular inspection conducted by the Technical Working Group within the area of Normal Holding Development Corporation on July 18, 2014, located in Sitio Canaro, Calabatuan, Canduyog and junction of Odiongan and Abongan Falls are the following to wit:

1. The Technical Working Group was able to reached the area inspected, verified and observed the real situation of the area by way of four wheeled, two (2) vehicles following plantation road, constructed by the Normal Holding and Development corporation.
2. Champada fruit trees which are already bearing were planted along the road going to the main camp in Canaro and Calabatuan.
3. Other fruit trees bearing seen in the area are marang, durian, lacatan, jackfruit, and Bangkok santol and none bearing fruit trees are lanzones, mangosteen and mango.
4. It was noticed that a portion of the area was also developed into a Riceland.
5. Aside from fruit trees, other forest specie planted and seen in the area are: Acacia Mangium, Albizzia Falcata, Philippine Mahogany, Gmelina arborea, and newly planted rubber trees.
6. Existing road going to the area was also observed including houses of the laborers and a storage (bodega) or packing house.
7. NHDC has also a 4 wheeled services vehicle for their use in their operation and doing emergency cases.
8. Proceeding further to the area particularly to the Abongan falls, we also noticed newly planted rubber and marang trees.

Remarks and Recommendation:

As per inspection, verification, and observation conducted within the plantation site of Normal Holdings and Development Corporation (NHDC), the following are the fact, findings, and recommendation to wit:

1. NHDC has complied the terms and condition as stipulated in their contract especially in the planting of forest and fruit trees of high potential value which is the main motive and purpose of the leasee.
2. NHDC has previously constructed accessible road going to their plantation site in Canaro, Calabatuan, and Canduyog to serve as access to protection development and link to market.
3. NHDC has also acquired Biceland area within the plantation more or less five (5) hectares for their consumption of their plantation crew.
4. NHDC has also constructed bank houses for their plantation crew.
5. There was no clearing or cutting of Indigenous trees seen in the watershed areas of Abongan.
6. The drops of water and flow of Abongan Falls and river is abundant and the water is still clear and not polluted and is evident or good sign that the watershed area is not disturbed or damage.
7. No landslide and erosion is occurring in the area.
8. Sooner or later, the Tree Farm Lease of Normal Holding and Development Corporation will create a job opportunity to the people of Abongan and the fruit trees planted of high potential value is also beneficial to the health of the people.


In view of the above facts and circumstances, we the composite team as Technical Working group expresses our volition to say that NHDC committed no violation into their areas of responsibility and obligation, instead a beneficial development is exhibiting in the area for the welfare of the forest environment and to the people of Abongan and neighboring vicinities.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, the team and Technical Working Group hereby recommends that the expired Tree Farm Lease Agreement (TFLA) of Normal Holding and Development Corporation (NHDC) be renewed to continue the sustainable management of the improvement and development introduced during the unexpired term of the said lease. Further, for them to protect nearby areas especially the watershed and contribute to the development of Barangay Abongan thereby creating job opportunities and improving the socio-economic condition of the constituents in the said area.

Furthermore, if ever the TFLA will be renewed, a multipartite monitoring team will be organized/established to serve as monitoring arm and to recommend further improvements if any in order to sustain the project more and in the future to come.



In compliance with your memorandum dated 03 August 2010 and PENRO Special Order Number 2010-020, please be informed that the joint validation team composed of PENRO and CENRO technical personnel conducted an actual assessment over the area applied for renewal of Tree Farm Lease Agreement owned by Normal Holding Development Corporation located at the above-mentioned barangay. The following findings were gathered and observed in the development of the area as established by the holder to wit:

**I. Background**

On JUNE 29, 1984 the then Minister Teodoro Q. Peña issued a Tree Farm Lease Agreement (TFLA) No. 484 to Normal Holding Development Corporation covering an area of 2,000 hectares located in Canaro, Abongan and Alcalian, Taytay, Palawan. The said agreement has a duration of twenty-five (25) years to expire on July 31, 2010 renewable for another twenty-five (25) years. The renewal of the agreement should be subjected for validation/assessment of the area to know if the holder has complied with the terms and conditions stipulated in the agreement.





## COMPLETE STAFF WORK (CSW)

### I. SUBJECT

Tree Farm Lease Agreement awarded to Normal Holding and Development Corporation located at Canaro, Abongan, and Alacalian, Taytay, Palawan.

### II. HISTORY AND CHRONOLOGY OF FACTS AND EVENTS

The awarded Tree Farm Lease Agreement is specifically located at 119°24'20.43" longitude and 10°39'53.47" latitude with an approximate horizontal distance of 21 kms from Poblacion proper of Taytay, Palawan. The subject area covers 2,000 hectares which falls within the timberland area, Block G, Project 9-O, LC 1614 September 23, 1952.

The NHDC is determining to engage in forest development/ reforestation activities using high valued crops. The following are the information as per record of this office to wit:

1. That on June 29, 1984 the then Minister Teodoro G. Peña issued a Tree Farm Lease Agreement (TFLA) No. 484 to Normal Holding Development Corporation covering an area of 2,000 hectares located at Canaro, Abongan, and Alacalian, Taytay, Palawan.
2. That the said agreement has duration of 25 years and the same was expired on June 29, 2009.
3. That on August 13, 2010 Foresters Constante B. Bose, Rogello L. Namoc, Elegio Adelantar, Forest Rangers Roldan Alvarez and Ronaki Villademosa submitted their report re: assessment/validation report on the environmental performance of Normal Holding Development Corporation holder of Tree Farm Lease Agreement No. 484 represented by Jose S. Buenavista located in Canaro, Abongan and Alacalian Taytay, Palawan (Annex A).

That based on the report submitted, it shows that the lease has religiously complied with the terms and condition stipulated in the agreement, hence, the processing and approval of the renewable application of the Tree Farm Lease Agreement is hereby recommended.

4. That on December 15, 2010, the Interfaith Leaders Initiative for Territorial and Development (IF-LIFTED) represented by Rev. Father Ruben Y. Casbay, Pstr. Flover U. Mijares, Pstr. Dan Anat, Pstr. Henry Espartero, Pstr. Joseph Endrico, Mr. Fred Delumpines and Mr. Simplicio Quillio sent their letter dated December 15, 2010 together with the Petition-Resolution of the legal residents of Brgy. Abongan, Taytay, Palawan to His Excellency, President Benigno Aquino III simply desire that the watershed for Brgy. Abongan be defined, delineated and secured for the livelihood of their people, and not to grant a renewal of lease to Normal Holdings and Development Corporation.

### III. APPLICABLE LAWS/ISSUANCES

- Section 20, PD 705 – States that no person may utilize, exploit, occupy, possess or conduct any activity within any forest land and operate any wood processing plant unless he has been authorized to do so under a license agreement, license or permit.
- Section 37, PD 705 – All measures be taken to protect the forest resources from destruction, impairment and depletion.
- Section 51, PD 705 – Management of occupancy in forest lands.
- Section 57, PD 705 – other Special Uses of Forest Lands – forest lands may be leased for a period of not exceeding twenty-five years renewable upon the expiration thereof for a similar period.
- Section 20, RA 7586 (NIPAS Act) – Occupation of timberland without tenurial instrument is strictly prohibited.
- Presidential Proclamation 342 dated July 12, 2000 – Declaring the Malampaya Sound situated in the municipalities of Taytay and San Vicente, Province of Palawan as a protected area pursuant to Republic Act 7586 (NIPAS Act of 1992) and shall be known as Malampaya Sound Protected Landscape and Seascape.
- DAO No. 17 series of 2007 – Rules and regulations governing special uses within protected areas.

### IV. JUSTIFICATION

1. That the lease started developing the area since January 1985. The said area was planted with the different types of fruit trees, forest trees and agricultural crops. Those trees that were planted are mango, durian and kalapi (palm). And those fruit trees are already productive.
2. That Rambutan and Champada were also planted along the road as vegetative measure to minimize the occurrence of landslide and soil erosion. Mangosteen and lanzones were also planted within the forest tree area. Other forest tree species that were planted in the area are mangium, mahogany, tsengkei and falcate. Those trees had already reached its merchantable height.
3. That the lease holder also maintained their nursery to sustain the seedling requirements for planting activities.
4. That the holder constructed a structure made of light materials as shelter for their staff and laborers.
5. That based on record, the holder is regularly submitting their accomplishment report. It is stipulated that the protection measures implemented in the area includes clearing/ removal of old debris and fire line construction, cutting affected branches/trees with pest and diseases and other forest protection activities to protect the lease area from any form of forest destruction.



6. The lease holder had also constructed an all weather road from Ibangle going to the main camp in Sitio Calabatuan and Sitio Canaro. An access road was also constructed going to area 3 and 4 in Sitio Canduyog. (Please see attached sketch map)
7. Attached herewith are pictures taken within the plantation of different fruit trees and forest trees in the area

#### V. RECOMMENDATION

In view of the above findings and considering that the lease has religiously complied with the terms and condition stipulated in the agreement and that the area is situated within Malampaya Sound Protected Landscape and Seascape, it is hereby recommended that the Tree Farm Lease Agreement should be converted into Special Use Agreement in Protected Area (SAPA) upon renewal of the holder.

The proposed Tree Farm Lease Agreement of Normal Holdings & Development Corporation concerns with the forest land use approach at So. Canaro, Brgy. Abongan, Taytay, Palawan. The Municipality of Taytay in Northern Palawan has (31) barangays. Abongan is one of its barangay and also known as "The Rice granary of the North". Barangay Abongan is located in the southwest of the Municipality of Taytay and about 180 kms. from the City of Puerto Princesa, Capital of Palawan. It is bounded on the east by Barangay Libertad and Paglaum, Taytay; on the west by Sto. Nino, San Vicente and on the Northeast by Barangay Bato and Alacalian, Taytay, Palawan.

Barangay Abongan could be reach in 3-4 hours over 180 kms. of concrete roads northward from the city of Puerto Princesa. Shuttle vans and passenger buses are the principal

means of transportation to and from Puerto Princesa. Within the inland barangays of Taytay, the general means of transportation are single motorcycles, tricycles and Jeepney which are either for family use or ferrying passengers or commodities.

So. Canaro which is 14 kilometers from the Brgy. Proper of Abongan could be reach by means of land transportation via So. Canduyog and/or 172 kms. from Puerto Princesa City.

The technical description of the proposed project area is shown in figure 1.1, and figure 1.2 is where the topographic location of the proposed project is presented.

### **1.3 Project Rationale**

In response for global warming issues, the company decides to invest in tree farming and support in promoting the environmental goals of concerned agencies. Environmental agencies are exerting much effort to achieve socio-economic progress attributed by tree farming. Environmental management and sustainable development is one of the company's goal. Moreover, the strong initiative shown by the local government units of Taytay to pursue the municipality's development thrust serves as added "pull factor" to entice external investors.

Generally, it is the contention of NHDC that its proposed Tree Farming project could enhance the environmental management and sustainable development of the area and contribute to the socio-economic growth of the municipality in general and Barangay Abongan in particular. Moreover it aims to:

- Contribute directly to the upliftment of the barangays of the municipality more specifically with Abongan through employment opportunities, enhanced taxation, education information and opening up of livelihood and/entrepreneurial opportunities and enhancement of the general well-being of the people;
- Secure for people with ill intend, improve and maintain the area for sustainable water supply of the barangay and near vicinities.

### **1.4 Project Alternatives**

While it not be denied that certain benefits may accrue to Abongan and other barangays in the vicinity, at the same time it couldn't denied that some people of the barangay may have certain apprehensions and doubts in their minds. Thus, studies on the bio-physical, and socio-

cultural-economic and people's perceptions and reactions have been conducted relative to the proposed project.

It is argued that if the proposed project will not be pushed through at So. Canaro, Abongan, however there would be significant sociological and economic losses to the municipality in general and to the barangay of Abongan in particular. However, tree farming of which the place has a very great potential will be affected. Consequently, the economic growth that municipality expects will not be realized. The proponent of the project if given the opportunity intends to pursue the project not only to gain company interests but to assist the community, considering the welfare of its people in general. Thus, the development of the Tree Farm in the area may enhance the economic growth of Taytay, particularly in Brgy. Abongan.

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT made and entered into by and between:

The DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES, with office address in Visayas Avenue, Diliman, Quezon city, represented herein by DEMETRIO L. IGNACIO, JR., in his capacity as DENR Undersecretary for Field Operations:

-and-

NORMAL HOLDINGS AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, a duly registered stock corporation under the laws of the Philippines, with principal office at 5/F Pacific Star Building, Sen. Gil Puyat Ave., cor. Makati Ave., Makati City with Extension office at 458 Rizal Avenue Ext., cor. Abrea Road, Brgy. Banca-Banca, Puerto Princesa City, herein represented by its Executive Vice President MR. ORLANDO R. BALBON JR., of legal age, and a resident of San Manuel, Puerto Princesa City hereinafter referred to as the NHDC;

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the DENR is the National Agency who has administration and management over protected areas under the National Integrated Protected Areas System, which includes Malampaya Sound Protected Landscape and Seascape (MSPLS). The MSPLS has an area of 200,115 hectares composed of the terrestrial and marine component, and management of which was granted under the Proclamation No. 324 dated July 12, 2000 and R.A 7586 known as NIPAS Act of 1992;

WHEREAS, the planning and development of the said Protected Area is administered and managed by PAMB. The municipality of Taytay has the largest area in biodiversity component and largest area covered by MSPLS;

WHEREAS, the NORMAL HOLDINGS AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION is engaged in activities that promotes sustainable ecological conservation and has offered to be in – partnership with PAMB in establishing sustainable tree farming project;

WHEREAS, the subject area of this Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) which covers about 2,000 hectare, is located within the Barangay Abongan, as certified under the ECAN Zone Map situated in the multiple use and core zone. ECAN Map of aforementioned area is hereto attached and marked an “Annex A” and forms an integral part of this Memorandum of Agreement;

WHEREAS, the MLGU of Taytay (Resolution No.001-2015), and the BLGU (Resolution No. 24-2013) and ECAN Board Resolution (23-2015), had favorably endorsed the renewal of tree farm lease agreement of Normal Holdings and Development Corporation in Barangay Abongan and that interposes no objection to the renewal of Tree Farm Lease Agreement of NHDC.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the foregoing premises, and in consideration of the mutual covenants of the Parties set forth herein, the Normal Holdings and Development Corp. should observe and comply as follows:

1. Shall submit to the MSPLS Management Board a Comprehensive Development And Management Plan (CDMP) which is supported by maps and technical descriptions of the boundaries of the proposed Project site;
2. Shall confine their development activities within the area specified in the CDMP;
3. Shall within six (6) months from the issuance of the Agreement, delineate and mark on the ground the boundaries of the area covered by the same under the supervision of the Protected Area Superintendent and shall preserve at all times such markers and other natural landmarks indicative of the boundaries of the area under this Agreement;
4. Shall submit to the MSPLS Management Board an annual report of accomplishments indicating management and development activities undertaken in accordance with its Comprehensive Development and Management Plan (CDMP);
5. Shall secure prior approval from the MSPLS Management Board and the DENR, of any changes in the management, ownership or capital stock of the company or corporation or transfer of the majority of the stock or shares of the company or corporation. Failure to do so without justifiable cause shall be sufficient ground for cancellation of the agreement;
6. Shall institute safeguards for the protection of existing endemic and/or threatened wildlife species in the area and ensure that no harm or damaged is caused to the ecosystems in the area.
7. That the proponent shall pay an annual user fee to the Integrated Protected Area Fund consisting the following:
  - 7.1 3% of the highest zonal value of the land of similar nature/character with that of the project applied for within the nearest barangay or municipality where the project area is located: and
  - 7.2 1% of the value of improvement.

That should there be new guidelines or relevant thereto, the proponent shall comply with particularly on the necessary adjustments of payment of

8. Shall ensure the safety of authorized visitors at all times
9. Shall ensure access of the Technical Review Monitoring Team (TRMT) to the project site as part of its regular monitoring and assessment activities;
10. Shall abide by the rules and regulations of the protected area and the terms and conditions stipulated in the harmonized General Management Plan;
11. Shall support the policies and programs of MSPLS;
12. Shall provide assistance to delineate and documentations of Barangay Watershed.
13. Shall provide Water System to the barangay as social responsibility of the proponent.
14. In case the proponent has plan for expansion, a separate MSPLS Management Board endorsement will be required;
15. All lumber requirements and aggregate materials for the construction of structures

19. In the event that the moratorium on the processing and approval of Special Use Within Protected Areas (SAPA) is lifted, the MOA entered into by and between the DENR and the NORMAL HOLDINGS AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION will now be converted into a SAPA, as amended, and arrangement will now follow the new Guidelines subject to the compliance with any additional requirements that may be required under the new guidelines.

The Agreement will be valid for twenty-five (25) years, subject to the periodic monitoring and evaluation of the MSPLS Management Board.

201 Ayon naman sa tagapanguna wala ng live fish cage and trading silang binibigyan ng permit  
202 kundi Wildlife Special Use Permit (WSUP) na lamang ang ibinigay sa ngayon.

#### 203 204 4. New Businesses

205  
206 a. **Research study of Ms. Christmas B. De Guzman entitled "Identifying**  
207 **ecosystem services and assessment of socio-ecological resilience in Malampaya Sound**  
208 **Protected Landscape and Seascape (MSPLS) using toolkit for the indicators of resilience in**  
209 **Socio-Ecological Production Landscapes and Seascapes (SEPLS) " and "Using species**  
210 **distribution modelling (SDM) to predict distribution and suitable habitats in a critically**  
211 **endangered reptilian species (Siebenrockiella leytenses, Philippine forest turtle)."**

212  
213 Ipinaliwanag ni Ms. Christmas De Guzman ang kanyang unang mungkahing pag-aaral na  
214 may pamagat na Using Species Distribution Modelling (SDM) to predict distribution and suitable  
215 habitats in a critically endangered reptilian species (Siebenrockiella leytenses), Philippine forest  
216 turtle. Ayon sa kanya ang layunin ng pananaliksik ay makakolekta ng mga pangunahing sampling  
217 points ng ibat-ibang uri ng Bakoko kabilang ang mga historical points nito base sa mga nakaraang  
218 pag-aaral.

219  
220 Ayon kay Bb. Christmas, nakapagsagawa sila ng tatlong (3) gabing pagbabantay at  
221 nakapag lagay ng tatlong (30) traps kada gabi na mayroong total na animnapung (60) traps sa  
222 loob ng isang kilometrong transect line sa mga napiling lugar. Kasama niya sa pagsasagawa nito  
223 ang ilang tauhan ng protected area para matulungan siya lalo na sa paglalagay ng mga traps sa  
224 gabi. Ang mga nahuling bakoko ay kanilang sinusukat at pinapakawalan din matapos  
225 maidokumento. Ito ang tinatawag niyang modelling na kung saan malalaman ang distribusyon ng  
226 mga bakoko sa kanyang tirahan. Matutukoy ng SDM na ito hindi lamang ang distribusyon ng mga  
227 pagong kundi pati na rin ang kanyang pinakamagandang tirahan na dapat protektahan. Nais rin  
228 niyang magkaroon ng mas malawak na kaalaman ukol sa kahalagahan ng mga pagong sa isang  
229 kumonidad lalo na ngayon na mataas ang potential nito sa medisina.

230  
231 Dagdag pa niya, may kabuuang bilang na tatlong (37) Palawan Forest Turtle ang  
232 kanyang naidokumento at ang Sitio Canduyog ang may pinakamataas na bilang ng pagong ang  
233 naitala. Sa ngayon ay ini-encode pa niya ang occurrence points ng mga pagong at mayroon  
234 kabuuang bilang na 69-70 points kabilang na ang 15 points mula sa katala at 10 points mula sa  
235 undergrad thesis na isinagawa sa Cabalugan at ilang points mula sa pag aaral ng CENRO sa Bgy.  
236 Alacalian.

237  
238 Itinanong naman ni Kgd. Ramonito Delaraga kung ano ang kahalagahan at tungkulin ng  
239 pagong sa ecosystem upang mas lalo sila mahikayat na dapat protektahan ang isang lugar.

240  
241 Tugon naman ni Bb. Christmas, base sa pag-aaral na isinagawa ng Katala Foundation Inc.  
242 ang bungang kahoy na kinakain nila ay ikinakalat sa iba't-ibang lugar. Dagdag pa niya, isa pa  
243 natuklasan sa pag-aaral na isinagawa ang snail na nakuha sa dumi ng pagong ay nagpapatunay na  
244 sila ay magsisilbing control sa peste ng palay.

245  
246 Iminungkahi naman ni CENRO Cayatoc na pagkatapos ng kaniyang pananaliksik ay  
247 kaniyang kausapin ang mga empleyado na may kinalaman sa pagawa ng Management Plan ng  
248 Protected Area at ipakita kung paano maiaddress ang mga banta sa pagong at sa tirahan nito.

249 Dagdag pa ni CENRO, bilang bahagi ng kaniyang pag-aaral kinakailangan din tingnan  
250 kung anu mga kailangan gawin upang mahikayat ang mga tao kung paano maprotektahan ito at  
251 ganun din sa mga dayuhang na nangangahas manghuli ito.

252  
253 Sa pagpapatuloy ni Bb. Christmas kaniyang inilahad ang pangalawa niyang pag-aaral, ito  
254 ay parte ng kaniyang master thesis sa United Nations University "Identifying ecosystem services  
255 and assessment of socio-ecological resilience in Malampaya Sound Protected Landscape and  
256 Seascape (MSPLS) using toolkit for the indicators of resilience in Socio-Ecological Production  
257 Landscapes and Seascapes (SEPLS)". Ayon sa kaniya, nitong March kasama ang dalawang  
258 Japanese at ilang staff ng DENR nagkaroon sila ng workshop patungkol sa nasabing gawain sa  
259 Barangay Pancol, Taytay, Palawan. Ang nasabing gawain ay isinagawa upang malaman ang sanhi  
260 ng mga ginagawang aktibidades ng tao sa ating kapaligiran at kung papaano pagkonektahin ang  
261 ecosystem ng karagatan at kagubatan. Inaasahan din niya na makapagsagawa ng workshop sa Bgy.  
262 Liminangcong sa pagbalik niya ng Palawan.

263  
264 Binigyang diin niya ang Social Ecological Production Landscape and Seascape (SEPLS)  
265 na kung saan nakapokus ito sa relasyon ng tao sa baybayin (*shore*) at socio ecological resilience.  
266 Ang pinaka layunin ng kanyang pag aaral ay mapalawak ang konsepto ng ecosystem services  
267 assessment at ecosystem resilience at kung paano gawing mekanismo ang ecosystem service  
268 assessment sa pang araw-araw na pamumuhay ng tao.

269  
270 Ayon pa sa kanya, nakapagsagawa na siya ng ecosystem services sa MSPLS at nakatuon  
271 ito sa Inner Malampaya Sound sa Bgy. Pancol at New Guinlo at ang hindi niya pa natitingnan ay  
272 ang trade off sa ecosystem services. Nagawa niya na rin ang workshop ng ecological resilience sa  
273 Bgy. Pancol ngunit ang hindi niya pa nagagawa ay ang "future landscape scenario" kung saan na  
274 gusto niyang mapag-aralan. Ang SEPLS manual na gianagamit niya sa kanyang pag aaral ay  
275 mayroon limang (5) bahagi na kinokonsider. Ito ay ang mga sumusunod: Landscape and Seascape  
276 diversity; knowledge and evaluation; governance and social equality; livelihood and well-being;  
277 biodiversity. Inilahad ni Bb. De Guzman ang mga larawan ng mga isinagawang workshop at ang  
278 mga natuklasan nito ayun sa nakuha niyang impormasyon sa mga dumalo. Ipinakita niya kung  
279 saan malakas o mahina ang komunidad base sa limang indicator ng SEPLS. Dagdag pa niya, ang  
280 susunod niyang hakbang ay isasagawa rin niya ito sa Outer Malampaya, ang ecosystem services  
281 assessment at habitat quality assessment at coastal protection ay sa Septiembre o Oktobre naman.

282  
283 Itinanung naman ng taga panguna kung humihingi ba siya ng endorsement sa PAMB para  
284 sa kanyang bagong proyekto at tugon naman ni Bb. De Guzman ay oo.

285  
286 Nang wala na iba pang komento at suhestiyon ay iminungkahi ang pag-endorso dito na  
287 sinang-ayunan ng mas nakakarami.

288  
289 **b. Research study of Mr. Dominic Wodehouse entitled "Predicting barriers**  
290 **to successful community Mangrove management and restoration."**

291  
292 Ibinahagi naman ni Dominic Wodehouse ang kanyang pananaliksik sa PAMB. Inaasahan  
293 niya na ang kanyang pag-aaral sa bakawan ng Malampaya Sound Protected Landscape and  
294 Seascape ay makatulong sa kumunidad at mga organisasyon tulad ng DENR at PCSD. Siya ay  
295 kasalukuyang nagpapakadalubhasa sa Bangkor University tungkol sa mangrove conservation and  
296 restoration. Ayon sa kanya, pinag aaralan niya ito dahil isa ito sa pangkalahatang problema ng  
297 mundo. Hindi lamang siya nagsagawa ng kanyang pananaliksik sa Cambodia, Honduras, Kenya,  
298 Indonesia, Sri Lanka, Thailand kundi pati rin dito sa Pilipinas kung saan pag-uuling ang problema  
299 ng pagkasira ng bakawan.

300  
301 Ang layunin ng kanyang pag-aaral ay upang matingnan ang mga pumipigil sa komunidad  
302 na magkaroon ng epektibong pamamahala at pagpapanumbalik ng mga nasirang bakawan.  
303 Pangalawa ay upang makabuo ng pinakamagandang istrategiya para sa pamamahala at  
304 papanumbalik ng bakawan ng komunidad. Inilahad din niya ang apat na espesipikong layunin ng  
305 kanyang pag aaral at ito ang mga sumusunod: *Community rules and sanctions; how does the*  
306 *community restore mangrove; what about community leadership; Community participation like*  
307 *mangrove planning & restoration.*

308  
309 Ang mga pamamaraang kanyang ginamit ay ang mangrove science & restoration tests na  
310 kung saan may dalawampung tanong patungkol sa bakawan at sa ekolohiya nito at sa kung ano ang

311 nalalaman nila patungkol sa panunumbalik ng kalikasan ng bakawan. Pangalawa ay nagsagawa  
312 siya ng biophysical methods- exploded survey method na mayroong sampung sample points kada  
313 transect. Isinagawa niya ito kasama ang iilang tauhan ng Protected Area upang magbigay ng  
314 assistance

315  
316 Ayon sa kanyang inisyal na resulta ng kanyang pag-aaral, naobserbahan niyang ang  
317 "kahirapan" at maagang pag-aasawa partikular na ang mga kabataang babae na maagang naging  
318 ina. Ang 4P's at ang pagpapalano ng pamilya at ang pagbibigay ng pension ay mabagal at  
319 mahirap. Kinakailangan pang paulit-ulit ang pag-follow up para sa mga senior citizen. Ang lahat  
320 ng ito ay lalong dumadagdag sa pinansyal na kagipitan at tumataas ang posibilidad na mamutol na  
321 lamang ng bakawan para may maibenta at magkaroon ng pagkakakitaan.

322  
323 Inirekomenda niya sa kanyang paglalahad na protektahan kung ano mayroon tayo katulad  
324 ng bakawan. Bawasan ang pamumutol ng mga punong bakawan at tulungan ang mga namumutol  
325 nito na bigyan ng alternatibong hanap buhay o kaya sanayin sila sa ibang pangkabuhayan katulad  
326 ng pangangisda. I-employ ang mga namumutol ng bakawan bilang mga Bantay Gubat. Magkaroon  
327 ng totoong tadhanang-parusa katulad ng pagseserbisyo sa komunidad, fines o mas mabigat na  
328 parusa para sa mga di tumitigil sa pamumutol. Kumuha ng maalintuntuning payo tungkol sa  
329 pagsasa-ayos ng mga apektadong bakawan. Bumuo ng network ng taga-nayon na mapagkatiwalaan  
330 sa pagbibigay ng impormasyon na kung saan agarang nirerespondihan ng DENR kahit dis-oras ng  
331 gabi. Bumuo ng alituntunin ang komunidad sa pamamahala ng bakawan, mas malalim na relasyon  
332 at garantiya sa pagitan ng mga taga-nayon at ng kanilang bakawan at ng DENR, at pag-momonitor  
333 para sa pagpapalano ng pamamahala.

334  
335 Nang wala na iba pang komento at suhestiyon ay iminungkahi ang pag-endorso dito na  
336 sinang-ayunan ng mas nakakarami.

337  
338 **c. Proposed Anchorage Area in Barangay Liminangcong, Taytay, Palawan**

339  
340 Inilahad ni Bb. Carol Esmenda ang resulta ng inisyal na assessment sa proposed anchorage  
341 area sa Bgy. Liminangcong at sa proposed bat and firefly conservation area sa Bgy. Bato. Una  
342 niyang prenisenta ang inisyal na assessment ng proposed anchorage area sa Outer Malampaya  
343 Sound sa pagitan ng Bgy. Liminangcong at Bgy. Tumbod. Ayon sa kaniya, isinagawa ito noong  
344 April 7, 2016 sa tulong ng DENR, MFI, PCSDS, LGU Tumbod, at BFARMC Liminangcong.

345  
346 Ipinaliwanag niya na matagal nang ginagamit ng mga commercial fishing vessels at marine  
347 tankers ang lugar na ito katulad ng Global Gas & Oil Carrier Inc at ng Animo Marine Hauler &  
348 Management Corporation ang area lalo na kapag masama ang panahon. Ito ay napag-usapan na sa  
349 Rules and Regulation Committee at dinala na sa PAMB noong nakaraang pagpupulong at iniutos  
350 na magsagawa ng inisyal na assessment katuwang ang WPU at PCSD kaugnay sa request ni Mrs.  
351 Gozar, ng Global Gas & Oil Carrier Inc at Animo Marine Hauler & Management Corporation.

352  
353 Ayon pa sa kanya nagsagawa sila ng Fish and coral assessment sa Bgy. Liminangcong at  
354 Tumbod at kumuha din sila ng sample substrate para sa analysis. Ipinakita niya ang sampling sites  
355 rotation kung saan pwede mag-talaga ng strict protection zone upang maprotektahan ang mga  
356 corals na magaganda. Dagdag pa ni Bb. Esmenda, mayroong average na 70% ng live hard corals  
357 sa kabuoan subalit mas maganda ang mga corales malapit sa Tumbod kumpara sa Liminangcong at  
358 ang pinakamataas na bilang ng isda na namonitor ay sa Tumbod.

359  
360 Ipinakita rin ni Bb. Esmenda ang pattern ng daloy ng tubig tuwing high tide at low tide.  
361 Ang salt sampling na pinag-aralan ni Cabrera et. al ay bahagyang ipinaliwanag ni Bb. Esmenda  
362 dahil sa konsentrasyon ng salt and sediments na kung saan naiipon ang mga nutrients sa maliliit na  
363 bahagi ng katubigan ng Liminangcong at Tumbod malaki ang posibilidad na ang mga nilimas na  
364 tubig at iba pang pollutants ay maaaring maka-accumulate sa inner sound at maka-apekto sa  
365 phytoplankton distribution. Kaya't iminungkahi ni Bb. Esmenda na dapat magtalaga ng polisiya  
366 dito at dapat magkaroon ng periodic monitoring upang masiguradong malinis ang katubigan. Base  
367 sa inisyal na pag-aaral, ang Bgy. Liminangcong ang pinaka-angkop na lugar para sa anchorage.

368  
369 Dahil dito inirekomenda ng tagapanguna na patuloy na magsagawa ng actual mapping at  
370 boundary delineation para maiwasan ang mga lugar na may korales. Magtalaga ng PAMB  
371 resolution para sa nasabing proyekto. Maglagay ng mga boya at magkaroon ng payment system at

372 polisiya para sa mga gagamit ng lugar. Kinakailangan din may regular na monitoring sa anchorage  
373 area para malaman ang mga pagbabago sa klima at anthropogenic effects.  
374

375 \_\_\_\_\_ Matapos ang presentasyon ni Bb. Esmenda ay ipinaliwanag ng tagapanguna na ang mga  
376 rekomedasyon ay nakasalalay sa PAMB. Nilinaw din ni Bb. Esmenda na ang aplikasyon ng  
377 anchorage ay para sa lahat kasama dito ang Ship-to-ship operation ng GGOC at AMHC. Dagdag  
378 pa niya hinati ito sa dalawang proposal (i.e anchorage at Ship-to-ship) pero hindi pwedeng  
379 magsagawa ng operasyon ang GGOC at AMHC hanggat hindi ito naaprobahan. Ayon pa sa  
380 tagapanguna kaya magsasagawa ng salt water quality monitoring dahil sa anchorage at ang Ship-  
381 to-ship naman ay magsasagawa ng sarili nilang pag-aaral.  
382

383 Ayon pa kay Bb. Esmenda kailangan makahanap ng lugar na hindi tatama sa mga koraless at  
384 malagyan ito ng mga boya. Dagdag pa niya ang anchorage ay proyekto una ng PAMB upang  
385 ikontrol din ang kalat-kalat na anchorage.  
386

387 Mungkahi naman ni CENRO Felizardo B. Cayatoc na tingnan ang water classification ng  
388 mga lugar. Magkaroon ng quality baseline at kailangan makita ang resulta nito upang malaman  
389 kung ito ba ay pasok sa pamantayan ng DENR. Dagdag pa niya, isangguni ito sa Committee on  
390 Rules and Regulations para mapag aralan ng maigi ang payment system sa paggamit ng lugar at  
391 makagawa ng plano tungkol sa magiging polisiya ng PAMB. Ayon pa sa kanya, mayroong account  
392 ang MSPLS sa ilalim ng R.A. 10629 na maaring ang maiipong kita mula sa proyekto nasasakupan  
393 ng protected area ay magamit. Ang 75% ng kinita ay pwedeng gamitin para sa operasyon ng  
394 protected area at ang 25% naman ay para sa ibang protected area na nangangailangan ng sapat na  
395 pondo para sa operasyon.  
396

397 Ayon naman sa tagapanguna isangguni sa Committee on Rules and Regulations ang mga  
398 patakaran tungkol sa proyektong anchorage area sa Tumbod at Liminangcong. Binanggit din niya  
399 na bago payagan ang mga mag-aanchor sa lugar dapat maglagay muna ng mga boya para  
400 maiwasan ang pagkasira ng mga koraless. Pansamantala ay gawin muna ang actual na boundary  
401 delineation at ang pagtalaga ng bayad.  
402

#### 403 **d. Presentation of results of the initial site assessment in the proposed "Bat and** 404 **Firefly conservation area in Barangay Bato, Taytay, Palawan.** 405

406 Ayon kay Bb Carolyn A. Esmenda ang tauhan ng PAWCZMS ay nagsagawa ng ocular  
407 inspection, mapping at panayam sa mamamayan na malapit sa lugar na matatagpuan sa Barangay  
408 Bato, Taytay, Palawan. Base sa kanilang isinagawang aktibidades wala silang nakitang paniki sa  
409 lugar ngunit nagkaroon sila ng nakitang palatandan na may nagpupugad na ditong paniki.  
410

411 Inilahad naman ni Bb Esmenda ang naging resulta ng kanilang isinagawang  
412 pakikipagpanyam mula sa mga mamamayan na malapit sa lugar. Ayon sa kanya, ang lugar ng  
413 Panikian ay tahanan ng fruit bats. Ito ay kalimitang mapapansin tuwing araw dahil sa kanilang mga  
414 ingay. Ang illegal na paghuli ang isa sa banta ng kanilang pagkaubos. Maaari din silang lumipat ng  
415 bahay dahil sa kakulangan ng pagkain.  
416

417 Kanya rin ipinaliwanag na kalimitang makikita ang firefly mula alas siyete ng hapon. Ito  
418 ay matatagpuan sa mga punong bakawan malapit sa ilog. Ang kahabaan ng lupa ay nasa isang  
419 kilometre subalit ang low tide na oras ay tinitingnang mas mainam para sa pagbisita dito.  
420

421 Sa pagpapatuloy ni Bb. Esmenda iminungkahi niya na magkaroon ng karagdagan pag-aaral  
422 patungkol sa nasabing uri ng hayop para malaman ang buwan na naroroon sila. Dagdag pa niya  
423 dapat magkaroon ng IEC patungkol sa kahalagahan ng mangroves at pagtibayin ang kakayahan ng  
424 barangay upang aktibong manguna sa pagpapatupad ng batas at pagprotekta sa lugar.  
425

426 Itinanong naman ng tagapanguna ang kagawad na representante ng Barangay Bato kung  
427 ano ang gagawin na magkaroon pa ng malawakang pag-aaral para malaman ang uri ng hayop at  
428 maideklara ito bilang Bat and Firefly Sanctuary.  
429

430 Dagdag naman ni kagawad Ailyn Rodriguez ang lugar ay kinabibilangan din ng ibat-ibang  
431 uri ng lamang dagat katulad ng mud crab at hipon. Bukod dito maprotektahan din ang mga ito  
432 upang dumami.  
433

434 Iminungkahi naman ng tagapanguna sa kapulungan na gawan ng management plan ang  
435 lugar para makita ang mga ipinahihintulot at di pinahihintulot na gawain.

436  
437 **e. Application for SAPA and/or MOA of Normal Holdings and Development**  
438 **Corporation (NHDC) at Barangay Abongan, Taytay, Palawan.**

439  
440 Inilahad naman ni PASu Alexander Mancio ang aplikasyon ng NHDC, ayon sa kaniya  
441 noong nakaraang PAMB meeting ay napag-usapan na ang aplikasyon ng NHDC patungkol sa  
442 kanilang SAPA application ngunit hindi ito naindorso sapagkat ang SAPA ay suspendido pa sang-  
443 ayon sa inilabas na memorandum ng opisina ng DENR. Ngunit nagbigay ng komento ang  
444 Biodiversity Management Bureau (BMB) na habang suspendido ang SAPA ay pwede silang mag-  
445 apply ng MOA.

446  
447 Hiling naman ni Ginoo Rustico Danguie sa kinatawan ng NHDC na kung pwede ipresenta  
448 na muna sa mga miyembro ng PAMB ang nasabing proyekto para makapagbigay ng nararapat na  
449 gawin para sa kanilang hinihiling.

450  
451 Samantala, inilahad naman ni Ginoo Jorgie Adier sa kapulungan na simula noong taong  
452 1985 na nakapagtanim sila ng puno na may kabuuang lawak na 500 hectares na pananim kung  
453 babasehan kaya unaapela sila ng karagdagang dalawampu't limang taon upang ipagpatuloy ang  
454 proyekto. Kaniya rin inilahad ang mga adhikain ng kanilang kompanya para sa iminungkahi  
455 proyekto. Ayon sa kanya, ang layunin ng kanilang proyekto ay Reforestation at Preventive  
456 Environmental Protection na kung saan ay naayon sa panahon na kinakapos na tayo sa tubig mula  
457 sa kabundukan.

458  
459 Dagdag pa niya, ang kanilang plano para sa nasabing proyekto ay upang ituloy ang  
460 programa nila na malapit sa watershed area, sila ay magsasagawa ng reforestation sa kapatagan  
461 upang pagtaniman ng rubber tree. Isa pa sa layunin nila ay makapagbigay ng karagdagang kita sa  
462 mga tao, scholarships program, pagsasanay patungkol sa tamang pag-aalaga ng pananim at  
463 pagprotekta sa ating kalikasan kasama ang mga mamamayan na malapit sa lugar ng proyekto.

464  
465 Itinanong naman ni Ginoo Rustico Danguie sa kinatawan ng NHDC na si Ginoo Jorgie  
466 Adier kung meron ng naisumite kopya ng mga nagawa ng proyekto sa opisina ng DENR mula ng  
467 nagsimula ang proyekto hanggang sa natapos ito.

468  
469 Sagot naman ni Ginoo Adier meron na silang naisumite noong nagsagawa sila ng  
470 imbestigasyon bilang pagtupad sa naging kasunduan. Tugon naman ni PASu Mancio mayroon  
471 silang hawak na inspeksyon at evaluation report.

472  
473 Inilahad naman ni Ginoo Danguie na ang kaniyang ibig sabihin na nagawa ng proyekto ay  
474 ang iba't-ibang programa na naisagawa noong panahon na natapos na ang proyekto. At para narin  
475 malaman ng kapulungan ang kakayahan at abilidad ng aplikante para sa renewal base doon sa  
476 naunang kasunduan sa opisina ng DENR na tinatawag na performance report. Dagdag pa niya kung  
477 wala naisumite maaari magbigay ng kopya ang aplikante para maging basehan kung irenew o hindi  
478 ang proyekto.

479  
480 Ayon naman kay PASu Mancio noong nag-aaplay ng renewal ang NHDC para sa kanilang  
481 Tree Farm Lease Agreement ay nagsagawa ang tauhan ng forestry kasama ang mga taga PENRO  
482 ng evaluation para sa renewal ng proyekto.

483  
484 Ayon naman kay Ginoo Danguie, mas maganda na mayroon sariling record ang PAMB  
485 upang may pagkukunan ng reference kung sakaling magkaroon ng problema patungkol sa nasabing  
486 aplikasyon.

487  
488 Ipinaliwanag naman ni Ginoo Ferdinand Fenix representante mula sa tanggapan ng  
489 Municipal Agriculturist Office, noong pinag-usapan ito sa PEC hindi ito pumasa sa kadahilanang
