Honorable Public Officials,

We, the Legal Rights and Natural Resources Center (LRC), on behalf of the delegates of the State of Indigenous Peoples Address 2023 national gathering, submit to you this letter of concern over various land and environment problems afflicting the indigenous territories of our participants.

There is a common trend of **lack of recognition of FPIC, ADSDPPs, and other indigenous rights** as a condition for issuing environmental compliance certificates, forest permits, land titles, and contract renewals, among others. There is also a seeming **regulatory capture** with illegal extractive and destructive projects abound, on one hand, and approval of projects despite lack of FPIC and social acceptability, on the other.

We specifically want to raise the following issues:

- In **Barangay Luac, Culion, Palawan**, illegal quarrying activities were reportedly operating in the ancestral domain of the Tagbanwa communities of Chindonan, Alulad, Lamud, and Marabal, selling aggregates to the Sunlight Ecotourism resort.
- In **Busuanga, Palawan**, various projects such as a resettlement area, tourism resort, cattle ranch, pearl farm, and biomass energy plant have been issued various clearances by DENR despite lacking free, prior and informed consent (FPIC), affecting Tagbanwa communities such as Sitio Lakdayan, Barangay Cheey, Busuanga; and Barangay Concepcion, New Busuanga.



2. On the Oceanagold mining project: On what grounds did the DENR clear the renewal of their Financial or Technical Assistance Agreement (FTAA)? Did the company apply for Free, Prior, and Informed Consent (FPIC), secure local government resolutions, and/or undergo environmental impact assessment as part of its renewal of its FTAA?
3. On the M&S IFMA: In the context of its lack of FPIC evidenced by the Supreme Court-upheld cease and desist order (CDO) issued by NCIP to their operations, what will the DENR's role be in its implementation being the granting authority of the IFMA? Can the DENR clarify the legal basis for M & S Company's utilization of the CAA as their security personnel?
4. On the coal mining projects by San Miguel subsidiaries: Did the DENR issue ECCs for the three coal mining blocks, and if yes, when? Have there been environmental impact assessments made on the possible indirect environmental and socio-economic impacts to our nearby ancestral domains? If there are EIAs, shouldn't these findings be presented to our communities as part of FPIC and the EIS system itself?
5. On the Tampakan mining project: Did the proponents conduct a new EIA process and secure a new ECC for its FTAA Extension? Was the EIS and ECC made available for direct and indirect stakeholders?
6. On the mineral explorations in the BARMM: Did the MGB grant mining exploration permits in the BARMM, and if yes, to which corporations and when? Did the DENR, Ministry of Environment, Natural Resources and Energy (MENRE) and mining corporations apply FPIC before the conduct of the geological mapping, sampling and survey?
7. On the pending NTFP permit: What is the status of the almaciga harvesting permit application of the Nagkakaisang Tribu ng Palawan (NATRIPAL)?
8. On the infrastructure projects within forestlands and protected areas: Did the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) pass through DENR and the Protection Area Management Board (PAMB) before the construction of the access road? Did the DPWH secure FPIC from the affected Indigenous communities?

We are very much open to further dialogue to discuss the above complaints and queries in the near future.

We hope DENR seriously considers the points we are raising in this communication and we are looking forward to your favorable response.

As (a) forest land steward(s), EDUARDO A. OMPIGAN commit(s) himself/herself/themselves to protecting and enhancing the ecology of the land specified in this contract and to joining with other stewards in the area in protecting and enhancing their natural resource base. In exchange for such a commitment, the steward(s) shall have the right to peaceful possession, cultivation and enjoyment of his/her/their forest landholding and the fruits thereof, the right to manage and work on the forest landholdings in accordance with appropriate forest land and farm methods and practices, and such other rights as may be granted or provided by laws, orders, letters of instruction, rules and regulations.

The steward(s) shall also faithfully comply with the obligations specified under the Stewardship Agreement hereto attached.

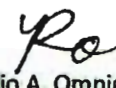

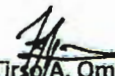
