Please be informed that on July 21<sup>st</sup>, during the onslaught of Typhoon Doksuri (Local Name: Egay), the Glass Bottom Boat of Apo Reef Natural Park docked at Sabang River in Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro, however, the typhoon caused the water level to rise and the current to become stronger.

As reported, the inside of the boat was flooded and was covered with mud. The timeworn hull which was donated by Scuba World in 2009 is already beyond repair since it already has some damage prior to the typhoon.

In connection with this, the disposal of the hull of the Glass Bottom Boat is hereby requested.

BOAT OF APO REEF NATURAL PARK CAUSED BY

TYPHOON DOKSURI (LOCAL NAME-EGAY)

The Glass Bottom Boat (GBB) of Apo Reef Natural Park was docked at Sabang River for safekeeping. During the onset of Typhoon Doksuri, also known as Typhoon Egay, on July 21, 2023, the water level at Sabang River increases along with strong current. The ARNP Rangers tried to remove the boat from the river, but its dilapidated hull and sidings were no longer viable to be moved. On July 24, the boat has water and mud inside. The roof structure and glass will be removed once it is safe for the PAMO Staff to go in the area.

The hull was donated by SCUBA World to ARNP in 2009 and was upgraded to GBB in 2020. Due to the age of the hull, it is no longer feasible to have it repaired. With this, the ARNP PAMO is requesting for the disposal of the hull of GBB. Attached with this are the photos, for your reference.
