

FACTS OF THE CASE:

Please be informed that on March 21, 2020 at about 9:00 PM this station conducted antiillegal logging at Barangay Tiguihan, Pola Oriental Mindoro that brought tom the confiscation of Narra logs with total volume of 12.93 m³ and market value of Php 548, 232.00. Investigation disclosed that said Narra tree was cut on March 15, 2020 at about 2:00 PM by one Gonzale Mampusti, resident of Barangay Casiligan with other three unidentified male factors and whom the owner of said Narra trees who facilitated the processing of documents were one Joaquin Lopez and Ponciano Torres both residents of Barangay San Antonio, Victoria, Oriental Mindoro but later on the certification to cut issued by Anastacio Santos, OIC CENRO was validated by PENRO to be invalid. Said confiscated logs of Narra tree were under the custody of Barangay Tiguihan, this municipalaity.
