**PROJECT** 

This refers to the verification of the undersigned personnel regarding the status of the request of the Office of the Provincial Government-Oriental Mindoro for the issuance of the Gratuitous Special Use Permit for the following infrastructure projects, to wit:

- 1. Construction/concreting of Rosacara FMR with three (3) bridges in Rosacara, Bansud, and;
- 2. Construction/concreting/rehabilitation of Brgy. Merit-Brgy. Concepcion, Victoria to Brgy. Ms. Concepcion-Brgy Happy Valley-Brgy Bugtong na Toog, Socorro FMR (with Bridge)

Based on the records of CENRO Socorro and CENRO Roxas, the said applications had been issued with the corresponding permits. These are the following:

- Brgy. Merit-Brgy. Concepcion, Victoria to Brgy. Ms. Concepcion-Brgy Happy Valley-Brgy Bugtong na Toog, Socorro FMR (with Bridge) - <u>Gratuitous Special Permit</u> <u>Number DENR-MIMAROPA-GSUP-2022-01</u>
- 2. Rosacara Farm to Market Road <u>Gratuitous Special Permit Number DENR-MIMAROPA-GSUP-2022-02</u>

On May 23, 2023, the office of CENRO Socorro sent a letter to the Office of the Provincial Administrator regarding the result of the inventory of trees in the area of Victoria and Socorro Farm to Market Road. Accordingly, there are changes in the route of this FMR that deviate from the original one previously approved by the Office of the Regional Executive Director, DENR-MIMAROPA Region on January 25, 2022. In the case of the Rosacara-Bansud FMR, there are no findings if there are also changes that deviate from the original proposed route.

The suggestion from the Office of CENRO Socorro is that since there are changes from the original route, the applicant needs to request the cancellation of the approved gratuitous permit previously issued for the Victoria and Socorro FMR and file another request for the issuance of a new GSUP permit. In the case of Rosacara and Bansud, if there are no changes from the original route, it is suggested that the expansion permit be requested to fast-track the construction of the said FMR.

Attached here is a copy of the letter of CENRO Rodel M. Boyles to Hubbert Christopher A. Dolor, MD, MPA, MHA, PAR, Provincial Administrator, and the GSUP Permit for Rosacara, Bansud, and Socorro-Victoria FMR.

This pertains to the letter request of Governor Humerlito A. Dolor to the Office of DENR Secretary requesting assistance for the issuance of the Gratuitous Special Use Permit (GSUP) for the construction/concreting of Rosacara Farm-to-Market Road with three (3) bridges in Barangay of Rosacara, Bansud, Oriental Mindoro with an approximate area of 3.94 hectares of public forest land.

## ADDITIONAL TERMS, CONDITIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS UNDER THE GRATUITOUS SPECIAL USE PERMIT

- 1. The area granted in this Permit (a) is a public forest land based on existing records, (b) shall not be involved in any private transaction.
- 2 The annual government share or user's fee is waived in favor of the Permittee.
- 3. The Permittee shall: (a) comply with the laws, rules and regulations and instructions now or hereinafter enforced for the proper use of the land. (b) respect any legal or prior claims; (c) conserve the corners and boundary lines of the area, (d) protect any wetlands such as spring, waterfalls, peatlands, swamps, lake and marshes or natural/historical/archaeological sites in the area; (e) report to the nearest local forest officer(s) all forest violations in the area and adjacent lands; and (f) submit a year-end report, not later than March 30 of the succeeding year, to the concerned Regional Executive Director thru the CENRO/PENRO the kind, number and value of improvement(s) introduced in the area, among others.
- 4. The Permittee shall (a) not appropriate for himself/herself the exclusive use of public trails traversing or adjoining the area or impede the use thereof by the public; (b) not sublease the area or any portion thereof, and (c) protect and conserve threatened, unique rare and endangered trees/plants/wildlife identified under existing rules and regulations.
- A separate permit shall be secured by the Permittee should tree curring be necessary. However, no tree, regardless of species, shall be cut in the permitted area if found within forty (40) meters from banks of rivers, creeks or streams and buffer strips. In case the said 40-meter strip is bereft of trees, the same shall be rehabilitated by the **Permittee**.
- 6. The Permittee shall strictly observe the terms and conditions of the ECC. In case the Permittee will conduct periodic rehabilitation of the infrastructures or introduce new appurtenances within the GSUP area, the same shall secure an appropriate clearance from the EMB for the purpose and submit the clearance to the concerned DENR Regional Office prior to such undertakings therein.
- 7 The Permittee shall strictly observe sanitary measures within the permit area to ensure protection of watershed values.
- 8. The **Permittee** shall protect the permitted area from forest fires and other forms of forest destruction.
- 9. Non-use of the area within six (6) months after it is granted will result in the cancellation of the Permit excent in cases of force maieure or fortuitous events

- 10. In case the area no longer serves the purpose as warranted under the said Permit, the Permit shall be cancelled and the subsequent management and administration of the affected area shall be assumed by the DENR.
- 11. Violations or non-compliance of any of the terms and conditions of the Permit or any environment and natural resources management laws, policies, rules and regulations shall be sufficient grounds for the cancellation thereof without prejudice to whatever legal action that may be taken.
- 12. The GSUP for the construction of roads and bridges shall have a maximum non-renewable term of five (5) years and similarly, the GSUP for the construction and operation of schools, hospitals, health centers, flood control facilities, water reservoir or impounding dam and its related facilities, air strip, landing site, harbor, public market, public plazas and evacuations site shall have a maximum non-renewable term of five (5) years. The GSUP and its additional terms and conditions shall be approved by the RED.
- 13 Except the agencies permitted to construct roads and bridges, the other agencies permitted to construct and operate infrastructure projects or facilities for public service and use shall apply for the issuance of Presidential Proclamation starting on the second year from the issuance of the GSUP to ensure effective management and sustainability of the infrastructure and facilities and its long-term use of the area where the infrastructure exists:
- 14 Failure to secure a Presidential Proclamation within the allowable period starting from the second (2<sup>nd</sup>) year to the fifth (5<sup>in</sup>) year of the GSUP, the Permittee shall apply for Forest Land Use Agreement (FLAg) pursuant to DENR Administrative Order No. 2004. 59 dated 31 August 2004 and other related policies on special uses of forest lands.



## ADDITIONAL TERMS, CONDITIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS UNDER THE GRATUITOUS SPECIAL USE PERMIT

- 1. The area granted in this Permit: (a) is a public forest land based on existing records; (b) shall not be involved in any private transaction.
- 2. The annual government share or user's fee is waived in favor of the Permittee.
- 3. The Permittee shall: (a) compensate for the portion of NGP sites that will be affected by the road development (2.83 bectares as shown in the attached map) activity by establishing a reforestation site or an upland plantation equivalent to the NGP area affected, and (b) shoulder all the cost for seedling production, plantation establishment and maintenance and protection activities until the third year, in accordance with the existing rules and regulations on the implementation of NGP.
- 4. The Permittee shall: (a) comply with the laws, rules and regulations and instructions now or hereinafter enforced for the proper use of the land; (b) respect any legal or prior claims; (c) conserve the corners and boundary lines of the area; (d) protect any wetlands such as spring, waterfalls, peatlands, swamps, lake and marshes or natural/historical/archaeological sites in the area; (e) report to the nearest local forest officer(s) all forest violations in the area and adjacent lands; and (f) submit a year-end report, not later than March 30 of the succeeding year, to the concerned Regional Executive Director thru the CENRO/PENRO the kind, number and value of improvement(s) introduced in the area among others.
- 5. The Permittee shall: (a) not appropriate for himself/herself the exclusive use of public traits traversing or adjoining the area or impede the use thereof by the public, (b) not sublease the area or any portion thereof; and (c) protect and conserve threatened, unique, rare and endangered trees/plants/wildlife identified under existing rules and regulations.
- A separate permit shall be secured by the Permittee should tree cutting be necessary. However, no tree, regardless of species, shall be cut in the permitted area if found within forty (40) meters from banks of rivers, creeks or streams and buffer strips. In case the said 40-meter strip is bereft of trees, the same shall be rehabilitated by the **Permittee**.
- 7 The Permittee shall strictly observe the terms and conditions of the ECC. In case the Permittee will conduct periodic rehabilitation of the infrastructures or introduce new appurtenances within the GSUP area, the same shall secure an appropriate clearance from the EMB for the purpose and submit the clearance to the concerned DENR Regional Office prior to such undertakings therein
- 8. The Permittee shall strictly observe sanitary measures within the permit area to ensure protection of watershed values.

- The Permittee shall protect the permitted area from forest fires and other forms of forest destruction.
- 10. Non-use of the area within six (6) months after it is granted will result in the cancellation of the Permit except in cases of force majeure or fortuitous events.
- It is case the area no longer serves the purpose as warranted under the said Permit, the Permit shall be cancelled and the subsequent management and administration of the affected area shall be assumed by the DENR.
- 12. Violations or non-compliance of any of the terms and conditions of the Permit or any environment and natural resources management laws, policies, rules and regulations shall be sufficient grounds for the cancellation thereof without prejudice to whatever legal action that may be taken.
- 13. The GSUP for the construction of roads and bridges shall have a maximum non-renewable term of five (5) years and similarly, the GSUP for the construction and operation of schools, hospitals, health centers, flood control facilities, water reservoir or impounding dam and its related facilities, air strip, landing site, harbor, public market public plazas and evacuations site shall have a maximum non-renewable term of five (5) years. The GSUP and its additional terms and conditions shall be approved by the RED.
- 14. Except the agencies permitted to construct roads and bridges, the other agencies permitted to construct and operate infrastructure projects or facilities for public service and use shall apply for the issuance of Presidential Proclamation starting on the second year from the issuance of the GSUP to ensure effective management and sustainability of the infrastructure and facilities and its long-term use of the area where the infrastructure exists.
- 15. Failure to secure a Presidential Proclamation within the allowable period starting from the second (2<sup>nd</sup>) year to the fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) year of the GSUP, the Permittee shall apply for Forest Land Use Agreement (FLAg) pursuant to DENR Administrative Order No. 2004-59 dated 31 August 2004 and other related policies on special uses of forest lands.
