The team shall perform the following characterization process.

- 1 Secondary Data Gathering
- 2. Primary Data Gathering
- 3. Preparation of Thematic Maps
- 4. Characterization Report
- 5. Vulnerability Assessment
- 6. Analysis of data and information gathered

The conduct of WCVA shall be in accordance with the FMB Technical Bulletin No. 16-A dated July 12, 2019, which provides the supplemental guidelines and procedures of watershed characterization and climate resilient vulnerability assessment of watersheds using science-based Geographic Information System (GIS) Remote Sensing and some commonly used biophysical and socio-economic processes and methods in pursuant to DENR Memorandum Circular No 2008-05 otherwise known as Guidelines in the Preparation of Integrated Watershed Management Plans"

The team shall prepare and submit the draft watershed characterization with VA to be reviewed by the Regional Integrated Watershed Management Plan (IWMP) Committee

The Chief Technical Services Division and the OIC. PENRO shall oversee all the activities on Watersned Characterization and Vulnerability assessment
