The Manila office of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) recently requested DENR to submit a report on the accomplishment of the department regarding co-financing commitment to various grant funded projects supported with funds managed by UNDP. The Global Environment Fund (GEF) is one of the sources of funds being managed by the UNDP.

The BD Corridor is a project funded by GEF and being assisted by the UNDP. As such, the BD Corridor is expected to include in their periodic report the status of co-financing committed by various agencies to the project. On the part of the DENR, the amount of co-financing committed was US Dollar 42,891,029 distributed as follows:
