1	Local TV Program	<p>The Local TV Program entitled “Talakayang Pangkalikasan ng DENR Marinduque” is being aired through Marinduque News Network focusing on the environmental advocacy which also serves as IEC for Public Awareness campaign that resulted to better appreciation by the general public on the programs and mandate of the DENR. Some of the positive impacts are the increased on application received for patents, supports from the general public in terms of ENR law enforcement.</p> <p>It features Special events and accomplishments of the DENR Marinduque, in collaboration with various stakeholders such as LGUs, other NGAs, CSOs, communities.</p>
2	Handog Titulo Program 2023 of DENR PENRO Marinduque	<p>In celebration of the Lands Anniversary and pursuant to DENR Memorandum Circular No. 2019-04, pertaining to the conduct of simultaneous distribution of land titles to beneficiaries, PENRO Marinduque distributed Free Patent titles to about 283 beneficiaries (144 residential, 131 agricultural, 3 quasi-public, and 5 school sites) on September 07, 2023 at Provincial Convention Center, Boac, Marinduque.</p>

3	<i>“Padyak para sa Kalikasan, Magtanim para sa Kinabukasan”</i> Year 2	<p>PENRO Marinduque’s <i>“Padyak para sa Kalikasan, Magtanim para sa Kinabukasan”</i> Year 2 aims to advocate for a healthy environment, raise awareness and encourage participation of various stakeholders in taking care of our environment, and widen the network of environment “Champions” to include bikers and volunteers in rehabilitating and protecting our environment through promotion of eco-friendly means of transportation, responsible eco-tourism, reforestation and other good practices.</p> <p>This meaningful activity started in 2022 in collaboration with the National Government Agencies, Provincial Government of Marinduque, Local Government Units (LGUs), Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), Non-Government Organizations (NGOs), various Bikers/Cyclists Groups in the province, and individuals supporting environmental activities.</p>
4	Rescued One (1) Philippine Brown Deer (<i>Rusa Marianna</i>) by PAMO field personnel	<p>The Philippine Brown Deer was found roaming at Sitio Walos, Barangay Bagtingon, Buenavista, Marinduque. It was reported to DENR-PAMO field personnel by concerned resident of said place. The wildlife species had a rope tied in the neck and observed tamed. DENR field personnel immediately responded on October 11, 2023 and removed the rope and then after released it to the wild. Continuous IEC and monitoring were conducted in the area and adjoining barangays such as Barangay Antipolo, Tabionan, Gasan and Barangay Duyay, Boac to protect it from possible illegal hunting.</p> <p>The incident was featured on GMA 7 through Kuya Kim’s segment on 24 Oras on November 8, 2023 and Born to be Wild on November 12, 2023.</p>
5	Provincewide Reinvigoration of Economic Skills in Butterfly Industry (PRESBI) – Livelihood and Value-Addition (LAV) Convergence Project	<p>The Provincewide Reinvigoration of Economic Skills in Butterfly Industry – Livelihood and Value-Addition Convergence Project aims to generate decent and productive employment so that every Marinduqueños can enjoy better and dignified quality of life. The spirit of cooperation of the Provincial Government of Marinduque (PGM) through Livelihood Manpower Development and Public Employment Service Office (LMD-PESO), Provincial Tourism and Culture Office</p>

		<p>(PTCO) and Non-Government Organizations (NGOs), Office of Congressman, Lone District of Marinduque, Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), Department of Labor and employment (DOLE), Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), Department of Information and Communication Technology (DICT), Department of Science and Technology (DOST), Overseas Workers Welfare Administration (OWWA) and Association of Cawit Butterfly Breeders Village (ACBBV) have come together to share resources and expertise in the implementation of the said project.</p> <p>DENR-PENRO Marinduque, together with other partner agencies, commits to support and be part of this endeavor for the Butterfly Industry in the Province of Marinduque.</p>
6	Partnership with University of the Philippines Los Baños (UPLB) on the Project “Greening Copper, Silver and Gold Mined-Out Area”	<p>The DENR-PENRO Marinduque in partnership and collaboration with University of the Philippines Los Baños (UPLB) will conduct collaborative research activities for the project entitled “Greening Copper, Silver and Gold Mined-Out Area” in Mogpog, Marinduque using endemic microbe and native bamboo and lesser-known tree species with industrial uses.</p> <p>The DENR-PENRO Marinduque will assist the UPLB on the establishment of nursery and field experiments to be conducted in the copper, silver and gold mined-out areas in Marinduque. The PENRO Marinduque provided a total of 1600 seedlings (800 molave seedlings and 800 narra seedlings) field experiments.</p>
7	Improvement of Materials Recovery Facility (MRF)	<p>Aside from the compliance to ISO 9001 2015, the improvement of Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) to support and improve management of solid waste management pursuant to RA 9003 or the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act that provides for a systematic, comprehensive and ecological waste management program and to ensure the protection of public health and the environment in PENRO Marinduque.</p>

8	Implementation of 5S (sort, set in order, shine, standardize and sustain)	The implementation of 5S in order to maintain cleanliness and orderliness at workplace has been conducted every last Friday of the month since January 2023.
9	Development of the Proposed Online PENRO Frontline Services Transaction System (Module 1: Biodiversity Management System)	<p>The DENR-PENRO Marinduque in partnership and collaboration with the Marinduque State College will design and develop an information system Online PENRO Frontline Services Transaction System (Module 1: Biodiversity Management System) that will incorporate real-time tracking into the system to enable accurate and up-to-date data on wildlife populations, provide online client registration and permit application that allows them to register and apply wherever they want, provide real-time monitoring and tracking of permits to increase compliance with regulations, and enable authorized users to access and share data across different departments and organizations.</p> <p>The proposed system features include User registration and authentication, Permit Application and Management, Payment Processing, Document Management, Compliance and Reporting.</p> <p>An initial Focus Group Discussion/ Consultation Meeting was conducted on November 21, 2023 at the DENR-PENRO Conference Hall, Boac, Marinduque.</p> <p>The implementation will commence, once the proposed budgetary requirement is approved.</p>
10	Enhanced National Greening Program (ENGP) Plantation Establishment Monitoring System for DENR-PENRO Marinduque	<p>The DENR-PENRO Marinduque is currently developing the Plantation Establishment Monitoring System which is designed to track and analyze various processes of ENGP projects including seedling production, plantation establishment and maintenance and protection.</p> <p>With the use of the system, updating and data retrieval will be easier and faster. Moreover, the system can generate various reports tailored to the needs of the users.</p>
11	Adaption and Implementation of the Proposed Human Resource Information System (HRIS) for DENR-PENRO Marinduque	The DENR-PENRO Marinduque in partnership and collaboration with the Marinduque State College plans to adapt the in-house developed Human Resource Information System (HRIS) of the Marinduque State College.

		<p>The proposed Human Resource Information System (HRIS) aims to offer a robust and user-friendly platform that enhances HR processes such as management of employees profiles, accomplishments, benefits, performance, and training.</p> <p>An initial Focus Group Discussion/ Consultation Meeting was conducted on October 27, 2023 at the DENR-PENRO Conference Hall, Boac, Marinduque.</p>
