Submitted are the enumerated activities that were undertaken during the fourth quarter, to wit;

- 1. That the maintenance and protection of the Marinduque Wildlife Rescue Center (MWRC) is a continuing activity being undertaken through periodic monitoring and supervision.
- 2. That a caretaker was sustained the feeding of the Philippine Macaques and Serpent Eagle that are under rehabilitative custody. He also maintained the facilities, tools and equipment of the MWRC such as comport rooms, cage for mammals and birds including portable cages for big and small animals and reptiles, safe hooks, pinning stakes, and plastic canister that is well kept in a storage room.
- 3. That food supplies were purchased and delivered to the Rescue Center regularly.
- 4. That on October 10, 2023, the undersigned reported the turnover of a Philippine Serpent Eagle (*Spilornis holospilus*) under the custody of Mr. Nelson C. Lee and Mrs. Leonora R. Lee in Barangay Mabuhay, Torrijos, Marinduque. Accordingly, the Serpent Eagle was rescued by Mr. Marc Andrew R. Garejo, nephew of Mrs. Lee, after super typhoon Ompong on September 15, 2018. The young Garejo brought the nestling to their house and took care of it for almost five years. Unfortunately, Marc Andrew died on a vehicular accident last September. Since then, feeding of the bird was done by coupled Lee. It was very difficult for them because they are old to take care of it, thus, requested this office to facilitate the turnover of the eagle. This Office immediately responded to the request of Lee family. The eagle was brought to the rescue center at Sitio Talisay, Bonliw, Torrijos, Marinduque for proper treatment and care before it will be released to the wild. In addition, one Reticulated Python (*Malayopython reticulatus*) was turned-over to the MENRO Sta. Cruz after it was caught eaten the fighting cock, Mr. Joaquin Regio at Sitio Galiangan, Boyabod Sta. Cruz. The snake has a body length of 2 meters and body weight of 2 kilos. The snake was released to the vicinity of MWRC.
- 5. That on November 13, 2023, a Reticulated Python was turned-over by Ms. Joymie Jalimbawa of Barangay Bachao-Ibaba, Gasan. Accordingly, the snake was captured inside the cage swallowing one of her hen on November 12, 2013. The captured python

has a body length of almost 6 feet and body weight of 2.5 kilos. The snake was released back into its natural habitat in the vicinity of Barangay Tabionan, Gasan, Marinduque.

6. That the unit had performed other duties and responsibilities as assigned by the OIC, PENR Officer, like the maintenance of seedlings replacement for cutting permit that were turned over to the Rescue Center. To date, a total of 85,570 various indigenous seedlings are being maintained by the caretaker in the said area.


