Greetings from the Philippine Competition Commission (PCC)!

This refers to the requirements relative to compliance with the National Competition Policy (NCP) for the grant of the FY 2023 Performance-Based Bonus under Annex 5 of the AO 25 IATF Memorandum Circular No. 2023-1.<sup>1</sup>

To this end, identified agencies were initially required to comply with specific requirements as part of their accountabilities on or before 30 November 2023 as set forth in Section 2.2 of the NCP guidelines:

*“The deadline for submission shall be **on or before 30 November 2023**. Agencies are also required to provide scanned or digital copies of the official submission and editable MS Word or Excel file for use of the NCP-PBB Secretariat.”*

In view of the foregoing and to provide agencies the full opportunity to comply with NCP-related agency accountabilities, the PCC is extending the deadline for submission of requirements until **30 January 2024 (Tuesday)**. Furthermore, this also serves as a reminder that compliance to these requirements will be used as basis in determining the PBB eligibility of responsible units and individuals. Hence, non-compliance will result in the isolation of the responsible units and individuals for the grant of the FY 2023 PBB.

The NCP-PBB Secretariat will continue to coordinate with your good office regarding matters related to this and shall provide a status report on the agency's
