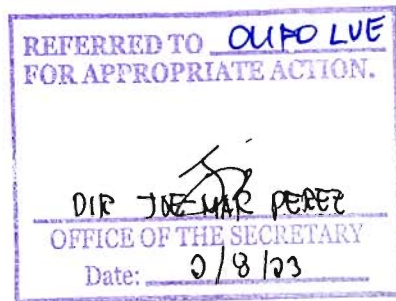

Dear Mme. Antonia Yulo- Loyzaga,

I am asking your good office to help me and to give us authorization to cut down trees in my property as well as the community in Port Barton San Vicente, Palawan because, I've been asking the good office of Cenro- Palawan since the month of April to give us authorization to cut down the fallen trees because of the typhoon Odette last December 2021, but until now no inspection is being done. How can we recover fast if the action is very low. President Duterte said authorization papers should be released in 1- 3 days, but almost a year, now we don't have authorization yet to cut our fallen trees. We can't plant vegetables, crops, trees, etc in our property. We need to clear up these fallen trees to avoid accidents also. We can't do this without the proper tools since these trees are big. We can also use these fallen big trees to improve our small kubo, but they are beginning to rot, because the DENR - CENRO did not inspect yet the damage of the typhoon until now.

So please, Madam, the Secretary, help us. The LGU said in Port Barton San Vicente, Palawan that, files of request papers are a lot in her office, since the most damaged place of the Odette typhon was in Palawan, but the DENR did not pass yet for the inspection in some areas. The LGU said they already resent a request letter since August.

Plese read my attached letter below for more information. If you wish that I will send you my mails to the DENR CENRO Roxas and to the LGU since April to June, I can send you. I called several times also through telephone The Cenro and the LGU for follow ups.

Hoping that in your office Madame, you can help me.
