<b>Objective(s)</b>	: To develop and improve the management of networks of marine protected areas and marine corridors within selected Large Marine Ecosystems (LMEs) in the ASEAN region for the conservation of globally significant biodiversity and support for sustainable fisheries and other ecosystem goods and services
<b>Description</b>	: The proposed ASEAN ENMAPS project could leverage other regional conservation investments of similar mandates in the ASEAN to scale-up in a more coherent and collaborative manner the MPA management and sustainable fisheries in the region. The project envisions transformative changes in the management of ecological networks of MPAs in the LMEs, building upon national initiatives to develop and manage MPAs and use of ICM and MSPs and increasing coverage of management and protection through conservation corridors. This upscaling of conservation areas aspires to attain improved support and sustainability to fisheries and other ecosystem goods and services.
<b>Status</b>	: A Regional and National Validation Workshop was conducted last 2-3 February 2023.  Capacity Development Baseline Meeting last 23 December 2022  Site Visitation Activities from August – November 2022  A National Inception Workshop was conducted last 18 July 2022  Currently, it is still under the PPG stage wherein the ProDoc will be refined/developed by the PPG Team, through conduct of series of stakeholders' consultation meetings.  A regional inception workshop was conducted last 24 May 2022.  Last January 2022, UNDP, with the assistance of ACB, started completing the recruitment of the Regional and National PPG Teams for the project.
