As part of the Senate's health protocol, the following additional guidelines will be implemented: All guests who will participate physically in meetings should present the following to enter the Senate premises:

2.) Negative RT-PCR test result with QR code or a Negative Antigen test result (both are valid for 72 hours from specimen collection) from any DOH- accredited facility. Self-administered antigen test results without any valid certification shall not be accepted.
