The DENR-Biodiversity Management Bureau and United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) are jointly organizing an event, entitled "Presentation of the International Consortium on Combating Wildlife Crime (ICCWC) Wildlife & Forest Crime Analytic Toolkit Report on the Philippines" to be held on 18 January 2023 at Makati Diamond Residences, Makati City.

The ICCWC Toolkit was developed by UNODC and other members of ICCWC which aims to provide a comprehensive analysis of the countries' preventive and criminal justice responses to wildlife and forest crimes. It is also used to identify the different actors in the wildlife and forest offences chain and to provide an understanding of the factors that drive their activities.

This toolkit was formally launched in the Philippines through a High-level Meeting held last 23 May 2022 followed by an in-country, in-depth analysis conducted by the UNODC experts on the country's response to wildlife and forest crime.
