2. This pertains to the Information gathered from BIN that on January 7, 2023 at about 6:00 to 7:00 PM an Alleged Explosion was heard in no specific place within the southern part barangay of this municipality.

3. In connection with the above reference, please be informed that on January 8, 2023, personnel of this station together with the 18th Special Forces Company, Philippine Army conducted validation re alleged explosion in the southern part barangay of this Municipality wherein interviewed residents stated that they heard an alleged explosion and saw a huge light above and further, based on statements of residents, they stated that they heard an explosion in mountainous area while others stated that they heard it coming from the sea, but during the validation and confirmation conducted there was no found any fallen debris within the possible explosion site. However, personnel of this station and other government agency in Rizal, Palawan are still continuously gathering information and validation regarding the alleged explosion.
