Dear PB L. G. Mayor, Jr.:

Please be informed that on 09 December 2022, the technical personnel of PENRO – Romblon confirmed that several local residents of Barangay Gui-ob, Alcantara, Romblon has been conducting sand and gravel activities at Madalag River, Barangay Gui-ob, Alcantara, Romblon, without a valid mining permit.

The above-cited extraction and disposition of earth materials is equivalent to theft of minerals pursuant to Section 103 of Republic Act (RA) No. 7942<sup>1</sup>, which provides that:

"Theft of Minerals – Any person extracting minerals and disposing the same without a mining agreement lease, permit, license, or steals mineral or ores or the products thereof from mines or mills or processing plants..xxx"

Hence, please monitor the illegal mining activities in your jurisdiction in accordance with the powers, duties and functions of a Barangay Chief Executive as stipulated in Section 389, Item No. 9 of RA No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.
