Pursuant to Executive Order 120, series of 2020, the Task Force Build Back Better (TFBBB) identified areas that bore the brunt of Typhoons Rolly and Ulysses (TFBBBI), which are namely: the Cagayan River Basin (Region I), Marikina River Basin (Region IV-A, NCR) and Bicol River Basin (Region V). Further, DENR Special Order 2022-32, designated all Regional Executive Directors (REDS) as Task Force Leads in their respective regions. Said Regional Task Force Leads shall be responsible for convening and coordinating with regional counterparts of Agencies designated as Head and Members of each of the six (6) Key Result Areas (KRAS) of the TFBBB. For Typhoon Odette (TFBBB2), Regions IV-B, VI, VII, VIII, X, and CARAGA were identified as harder-hit areas.

During the 33rd Task Force Build Back Better meeting dated 19 April 2022, part of the Summary of Agreements is for Regional TFBBB to provide monthly status/situation reports and updates/accomplishments on the implementation plans of its Key Results Areas. In line with this, may we request for your continued submission every 5th of the following month for inclusion in the quarterly reports for FY 2023.
