Dear Dr Mojares (or colleague),

I am in receipt of a copy of your memo dated 29 April 2022. I understand from that memo that our project area overlaps with four parties who have applications with MGB for mining activities.

After studying their areas on the supplied map, I do not see any major conflict between their proposed mining activities and our project. Our project only requires land area sufficient to build 3 small weirs, a forebay and a powerhouse, with a narrow strip between these for a canal and project access roads.

As to use of the water for our project, we are in final stages of obtaining water permits for the Batang-batang river (Weir I) and two tributaries (Weir II and III) from NWRB. We have FPIC certificate with the IPs of the area, as negotiated via NCIP, our DOE Service Contracts are in good stead, and we have endorsements from barangay, city and provincial levels. We have a contract in place with PALECO for sale and distribution of the generated electricity; Palawan is for some time suffering power brownouts, and I believe Palawenos are in favor of our carbon-emission free electricity rather than coal-fired generation.

I hope you can advise us of what are the requirements to obtain the MGB Clearance so we can move our project forward. I hope you will please respond to this email; I am currently out of Manila, so perhaps we could follow up with a Teleconference.
