Conservation International Philippines, under the *Community, Conservation, and Natural Climate Solutions (CCNCS): Mantalingahan Landscape Conservation Project*, will conduct a **forest carbon inventory training** as part of our capacity development initiative. This training aims to capacitate community and government partners in forest inventory techniques that would be useful for carbon plot monitoring and validation. It will involve a one-day classroom session and a three-day field training that will be conducted in select terrestrial and mangrove forests in the municipalities of Brooke's Point and Rizal, Palawan.

In this regard, we would like to invite one technical staff from your office to participate in this four-day training which will be held on **January 11-14, 2023** at **Maruyog Farms and Garden Resort, Brooke's Point, Palawan**. They should also be physically fit for the field exercises that are part of the training.
