Greetings of Peace!

The Biodiversity Conservation Society of the Philippines (BCSP), formerly the Wildlife Conservation Society of the Philippines (WCSP), is an organization of wildlife researchers, managers, scientists, and conservationists. We aim to advance biodiversity research and conservation in the Philippines by facilitating communication and contributing to improved research and conservation capabilities of those working on Philippine biodiversity, and to increase public awareness, appreciation, and understanding of Philippine biodiversity.

One of the key programs of the BCSP is the Philippine Biodiversity Symposium, an annual gathering of Filipino and international researchers and practitioners working in the fields of wildlife studies and biodiversity conservation in the Philippines. Symposium activities include institutional exhibits of organizations involved in biodiversity research and conservation, keynote presentations from distinguished wildlife scientists and conservation practitioners, workshops, and contributed oral and poster presentations by researchers, conservationists, and both high school and undergraduate students. The symposium draws over 250 participants yearly from academic and research institutions, government agencies, non-governmental organizations, and the private sector.

This year, BCSP is hosting the 31st Annual Philippine Biodiversity Symposium with the Energy Development Corporation in the City of Sorsogon from August 22 to 25, with the theme "Priority Conservation Actions to Sustain Philippine Biodiversity." The symposium is open to all biodiversity researchers, conservation managers, and advocates of Philippine biodiversity. We welcome contributions for oral and poster presentations, workshops, institutional exhibits, and other side events.

We encourage all symposium participants to pre-register and pay in advance online to provide organizers an estimate of the number of on-site attendees. While we will strive to accommodate everyone, we will be prioritizing participants who pre-register with proof of payment over walk-ins at SSU.
