EGAY (INTERNATIONAL NAME: DOKSURI) AS OF 3:00 PM

OF JULY 26, 2023

Respectfully submitting the situational report on Typhoon Egay (International Name: Doksuri) as of 3:00 pm of July 26, 2023. Please be informed on the following latest weather update within our Area of Responsibility (1st District of the Province of Oriental Mindoro):

1. WEATHER CONDITION (CALAPAN CITY, ORIENTAL MINDORO: PROVINCIAL CAPITOL)

- Cloudy (94% cloud cover and 500 m cloud ceiling)
- 90% probability of precipitation; 7.1 mm precipitation
- Temperature of 30° c (reel feel 37° c and reel feel shade of 35° c)
- Wind gust of 21 km/h moving SW 8 km/h
- The weather forecast tonight will have an occasional rain and a thunderstorm
- The weather forecast tomorrow will have a stray afternoon thunderstorm

2. ROADS AND BRIDGES

• The road of Barangay Andres Ylagan, Naujan, Oriental Mindoro as of 10:00 am have water level of 14 in/ 1.2 ft which are not passable to light vehicle

3. FLOODED AREAS

• Barangay Andres Ylagan, Naujan, Oriental Mindoro as of 10:00 am

4. INCIDENT MONITORED

5. EVACUATION

6. POWER AND COMMUNICATION INTERRUPTION

- Power interruption occurred in the Municipalities of Puerto Galera (portion), Naujan (portion) and Victoria, Oriental Mindoro but were immediately energized by Oriental Mindoro Electric Cooperative before noon
- No communication interruption within our AOR

7. WATER LEVEL IN PRINCIPAL RIVERS

- Water level in Mag-asawang Tubig River as of 10:00 am is in Orange Level
- Water level in Alag River as of 6:34 am is in Critical Level
- Water level in Lungos River as of 6:26 am is in Normal Level
- Water level in Panggalaan River as of 5:56 am is in Orange Level
- Water level in Bucayao River as of 5:50 am is in Orange Level

8. ACTIONS TAKEN

- Continuous monitoring of Typhoon Egay
- Continuous monitoring of our AOR to prevent possible environmental disaster caused by Typhoon Egay (e.g. landslide, flood, oil spill)
- Strengthened coordination, linkage and partnership with LGUs and other stakeholders

9. WORK & SCHOOL

- No work suspension within our AOR
- No school suspension within our AOR

10. RELIEF DISTRIBUTION

11. OTHER INFORMATION


- The Province of Oriental Mindoro to date does not have any storm warning signal
- Calapan Port resumed its operation this day

The Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration issued the latest update on Typhoon Egay at 2:00 pm of this even date. The eye of the typhoon is located in the coastal waters of Calayan (Dalupiri Is.), Cagayan (19.1 °N, 121.0 °E) moving Northwestward at 10 km/h. Typhoon Egay currently has maximum sustained winds of 175 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 240 km/h.

This office shall provide the latest update within our AOR, and continuously coordinate with concerned LGUs and other stakeholders to provide public service to people even in this time of natural disaster.


