HABITUAL ABSENCE IN THE OBSERVANCE

OF FLAG CEREMONY

It has come to the knowledge of the undersigned that you already incurred more than three (3) consecutive absences in our flag ceremony attendance. As I examined the records, it has been discovered that you habitually filed your sick leave every Monday. In Section 44 of the Rules and Regulations Implementing Republic Act No. 8491 series of 1998 otherwise known as "The Code of the National Flag, Anthem, Motto, Coat-of-Arms and Other Heraldic Items and Devices of the Philippines," to wit:

Section 44. All officials and employees of the national and local governments, and any agencies or instrumentalities thereof, including government-owned or controlled corporations, institutions of learning, and privately-owned entities or offices displaying the National Flag are hereby directed to comply strictly with the rules prescribed for the rendition of the National Anthem.

Also, the undersigned want to highlight Paragraph three (3) of the Civil Service Commission - Memorandum Circular No. 19 series of 2012 "Observance of Flag Ceremony" substantially provides:

"To ensure that government employees regularly accord respect to the Philippine Flag and to provide a venue where they will be constantly reminded of how they must conduct themselves as public servants, all heads of government agencies are enjoined to schedule a flag-raising ceremony every Monday, or the next working day if Monday is declared a holiday, and a flag-lowering ceremony every Friday or on the last working day of each week. Agencies are advised to conduct the flag-raising and flag-lowering ceremonies at 8 o'clock in the morning and 5 o'clock in the afternoon, respectively."

Please explain within seven (7) working days (upon receipt of this memorandum) why the undersigned shall have no reason to file any administrative charge against you.

E.O. No. 292 otherwise known as the "Administrative Code of 1987" states that:

1st offense means Reprimand 2nd offense means a Suspension 3rd offense means Termination from the service
