

QUARTER CY 2023

I. REFERENCE

In compliance with the Work and Financial Plan (WFP) for FY 2023 under the Natural Resources Sustainably Managed, Natural Resources, Enforcement and Regulatory Program (Forest and Forest Resources Use), Item No. 4 Performance Evaluation of CSCs outside CBFMAs (devolved CSCs) including expired, and expiring CSCs, Re-evaluation of CSC, please be informed that the undersigned conducted re-evaluation of performance of CSC holders located in Barangays Canat and Bayuti, Boac, Marinduque.

II. BACKGROUND

Per Work and Financial Plan of PENRO Marinduque for FY 2023, this Office has a target of Nineteen (19) CSC lots recommended for re-evaluation by the Regional Office. This is in accordance with Section 4 of DENR Memorandum Circular No. 21 June 30, 1993 entitled "Revised Procedures on the Conduct of Performance Evaluation of Stewardship Agreement, Cancellation and Compensation of the Holders Thereof". Per record, this Office had already re-evaluated a total of Six (6) CSC lots for the First Quarter CY 2023.

Prior to the CSC re-evaluation, the team coordinated with the concerned Barangay Local Government Units (BLGU) regarding the re-evaluation/assessment of the performance of the Holders of Certificate of Stewardship Contract (CSC) within their administrative jurisdiction.

In addition, the team had also posted a "Patalastas" in a conspicuous area in the concerned Barangay Halls with an attached list of CSC holders to be re-evaluated. In addition, the undersigned also coordinated with the CSC holders and/or authorized representatives on the schedule of ground re-evaluation of the CSC areas.

III. FINDINGS/RESULTS:

Hereunder the following are the findings and results of the activity, to wit:

- That the team had coordinated with the concerned Barangay Local Government Units regarding the re-evaluation/assessment of the performance of the Holders of Certificate of Stewardship Contract (CSC) within their administrative jurisdiction;
- Per coordination with the Barangay Officials, the CSC holder target for re-evaluation are either dead or already migrated to other places to live. All available heirs are also not

interested in continuing the contract since they already shift to other sources of living other than the cultivation of crops in the mountain.

 Based on the record these CSC areas were also recommended for cancellation in the 2021 CSC evaluation due to the same reason that the holder or its heirs are not willing to continue the contract

IV. ISSUES AND CONCERNS:

The following are the common issues and concerns being encountered by the Team during the re-evaluation, to wit:

- 1. All Certificate of Stewardship Contracts were already expired and need renewal by their authorized parties to legalize occupancy over the ISF lot;
- 2. Most of the CSC holders are either deceased or old that cannot perform the duties stipulated in the CSC contract. Further, the immediate family members of the CSC holders were not interested anymore to take over the responsibility over the CSC lot;

V. REMARKS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. To issue a cancelation order over the abandoned Certificate of Stewardship Contracts (CSCs) lots to be copy furnished to the concerned Barangay Local Government Units (BLGUs) and PENR Office.
- 2. To coordinate with the Protected Area Management Office regarding the monitoring of the CSC lots and possible conversion of the tenurial instrument (CSC) to another tenurial instrument based on Protected Area policy, rules and regulation.
