i found this Email address on the DENR website.

My name is Martin Zimmermann, we (my wife Filipino citizen and myself) moved last week for good to Puerto Galera.

We ship our complete household goods in a container where is still on the way.

My shipper told me that I must get an import permission from DENR for my used hand tools.

We try to call DENR in Calapan to ask how to apply for such a permission, but we just get some phone number where we can't reach anyone.

Our whole household will not release by customs if we don't have this permission, said the shipper.

Please are you able to route me to the corresponding person to go forward?

In my country, Switzerland, we don't need permission to import used hand tools, that's why I'm a bit confused and don't know where I can ask.

The following list is the items where the shipper says its need import permission:

• Jigsaw.

• Hardwood blocks around 10pcs.

Are used to make small decorations or similar. Means cut and carve or sandpaper to get a keyring as example. The Size of the blocks are the double of a package of cigarretes or around five Mobile Phones together. The Wood is elder wood.



Gardensaw

This I bought it last year 2022.



• chainsaw

I bought this in year 200. Its NOT with gasoline motor, is a version with electric wire to plugin to 230V. The chain is just 30cm long (around 12").
