URGING THE OFFICE OF THE PROVINCIAL AGRICULTURE, PALAWAN COUNCIL FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT (PCSD), BUREAU OF FISHERIES AND AQUATIC RESOURCES (BFAR), NATIONAL COMMISSION ON INDIGENOUS PEOPLES, DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES (DENR), PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP)-MARITIME, PHILIPPINE COASTGUARD, AND CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS, TO REVIVE AND REACTIVATE THE SOUTHERN PALAWAN INITIATIVE DEDICATION FOR ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT (SPIDERMAN)

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 8550 (Philippine Fisheries Code of 1998) as amended by Republic Act No. 10654, Republic Act No. 7586 (NIPAS Act) as amended by Republic Act No. 9147 (Wildlife Resources Conservation and Protection Act) and the Republic Act No. 7160 (Local Government Code), as amended are the laws promoting the establishment of marine protected areas in the country;

WHEREAS, Marine Protected Areas (MPA) are area of the sea established and set aside by law, administrative regulation, or any other effective means in order to conserve and protect a part of or the entire enclosed environment through the establishment of management guidelines;

WHEREAS, in August 2019 the Municipal Mayors of Aborlan, Narra, Sofronio Espanola, Bataraza and Brooke's Point signed an agreement to protect, restore and conserve key marine biodiversity areas in their municipalities and formed a task force named "SPIDERMAN" or the Southern Palawan Initiative Dedication for Environment Protection and Management which aims to protect Marine Protected Area Network (MPAN):

WHEREAS, this initiative is pursuant to the Strengthening Marine Protected Areas to Conserve Marine Key Biodiversity Areas in the Philippines (SMARTSeas), development program of the United Nations to address the rapid deviation of marine and coastal habitats;

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) entered into likewise solicits the combined efforts of the Provincial Government through the Office of the Provincial Agriculture, Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD), Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR), National Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP), Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), Philippine National Police (PNP)-Maritime, Philippine Coastguard, Civil Society Organizations (CSO), and other stakeholders;

WHEREAS, there is a need to revive and reactivate the now inactive SPIDERMAN task force to manage the MPAN in the Southern part of Palawan and to enable a policy framework of marine biodiversity conservation in the area.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Ryan D. Maminta duly seconded, be it

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to urging the Office of the Provincial Agriculture, Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD), Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR), National Commission on Indigenous Peoples, Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), Philippine National Police (PNP)- Maritime, Philippine Coastguard, and Civil Society Organizations, to revive and reactivate the Southern Palawan Initiative Dedication for Environment Protection and Management (SPIDERMAN);

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished to the Office of the Provincial Agriculture, Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD), Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR), National Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP), Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), Philippine National Police (PNP)-Maritime, Philippine Coastguard, and Civil Society Organizations, all of this Province, for their information and appropriate action.
