ACTIVITY REPORT ON THE CONDUCTED COASTAL AND MARINE RESOURCES ASSESSMENT AND MONITORING FOR DRY SEASON 2023

June 12-16, 2023

As part of the target activities of Snake Island – National Coastal and Marine Center for Research for CY 2023, the SIMO hosted the conduct of dry season coastal and marine resources assessment and monitoring at Snake Island NCMCR, Honda Bay on June 12-16, 2023.

A total of twenty-eight (28) participants joined the activity, composed of nineteen (19) males and nine (9) females with representatives from BMB – Coastal and Marine Division, ERDB – Coastal Zone and Freshwater Ecosystems Research Division, Regional Office – Conservation and Development Division, CENRO Taytay, CENRO Puerto Princesa, City ENRO, Palawan Council for Sustainable Development Staff, PENRO Palawan – Conservation and Development Section and the Snake Island Management Office (SIMO) as host of the activity.

On May 25, 2023, a levelling off meeting was conducted with the team via Zoom as part of the preparation for the assessment as well as to discuss the materials needed by the team.

On day 1, upon the arrival at PPS International Airport, the participants proceeded to the Snake Island Management Office. The following team were assigned to respective components:

The actual assessment was completed on the following days. Unfortunately, due to some power source problems for the operation of the dive compressor, the corals and fish components were able to accomplish only 5 out of 6 established stations. The remaining station will be surveyed by the SIMO team. The existence of Crown-of-Thorns was noted in Station 1 according to the corals and fish team's observations.

The seagrass and macrobenthos monitoring team conducted the survey at four (4) established monitoring stations. For station 1, the transect line began at about 3 to 4 feet deep, this is due to the Typhoon Odette that hit the island last December 2021 which caused a sand shift and the covering of seagrass beds near the shoreline of monitoring Station 1. Fortunately, sand shift did not occur in other monitoring stations.

The mangroves monitoring team conducted the survey along the damaged trees on the established permanent plots. They also re-painted and marked the permanent plots.

Surface water samples were analyzed *in situ* using the HORIBA U-53 Water Quality Checker. The following parameters were measured: temperature, pH, oxidation-reduction potential (ORP), conductivity, turbidity, dissolved oxygen, Total Dissolved Solids (TDS), Nitrate-N, Ammonia-N, Phosphate, Total Suspended Solids (TSS) and salinity. A total of 9 stations were sampled, six (6) samples from coral reefs monitoring stations and three (3) samples from seagrass monitoring stations as additional site.

The CPCE, FVC, and Rugosity data from corals and fish components will be processed by the SIMO staff, BMB, and PCSDS to be forwarded to the ERDB for analysis, interpretation, and technical writing. Furthermore, the raw data for mangrove, seagrass, and macrobenthos components had already been obtained and processed by ERDB technical personnel. Moreover, the data on the avifauna community will be forwarded to ERDB once it is processed and submitted by the City ENRO.





Seagrass team during the survey and group photo in the survey site




Macrofauna team during the survey and group photo in the survey site
