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#### I. PRELIMINARIES

Engr. Glenn Marcelo C. Noble, Chairperson and MGB MIMAROPA Regional Director, called the meeting to order at 2:50 p.m. upon confirmation of a quorum (9 out of 10) by the secretariat.

#### II. MEETING PROPER

#### A. Review and Approval of the Provisional Agenda

The Chairperson requested the committee members to peruse the Provisional Agenda for the 1st Quarter 2023 MRFC meeting, for any comments and/or additional issues/concerns/topics for inclusion in the agenda.

The following topics/concerns were requested to be included in the "Other Matters" for discussion:

- Letter of the Environmental Legal Assistance Center regarding the investigation on RTNMC's Compliance with ECC conditions and Contreras' complaint
- Land Dispute Update (Nieves Cruz)
- Tugboat incident update by Mr. Magallanes.
- Clarification on SEP Clearance
- Mine Cross Visit to Surigao del Norte

Without objections to the additional matter, the body approved and adopted the provisional agenda for the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2023 MRFC Meeting thru the motion of Atty. Noel E. Aquino (LGU Palawan), seconded by Mr. Inocencio C. Magallanes (Haribon Palwan).

# B. Review and approval of the Draft Minutes of the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2022 MRFC meeting held on 12 December 2022

The Chairperson requested the committee for comments on the draft minutes of the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2022 MRFC meeting for RTNMC.

The minutes for the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter MRFC meeting for RTNMC was conditionally approved, subject for comments/corrections until 12 PM the following day.

#### C. Matters Arising from the Minutes of the 4th Quarter MRFC Meeting

### Relocation of Informal Settlers in the Coastal Sitios of Marabajay and Tagdalungon

For update, MENRO Reynaldo C. Rivera (MLGU Bataraza) stated that he will be requesting for a copy of the site development plan of the relocation site from the Municipal Planning and Development Office. Further, he stated that a meeting was conducted regarding a project for constructing

a sea wall and was already approved with a fund of approximately PHP200 Million, which will come from the DPWH.
 Consolidation of RTNMC's Environmental Compliance Certificates (ECC)

According to Engr. Mark Angelo S. Rogel (EMB MIMAROPA), they are yet to receive a response from the EMB CO regarding this matter. The Chairperson requested EMB MIMAROPA to coordinate accordingly with the EMB CO regarding this matter.

#### 3. Presentation of Highlights of the 3rd Quarter 2022 MMT Validation

#### On Mr. Magallanes's Proposal to Revisit RTNMC's ECC

Engr. Rogel stated that per latest monitoring, the company complied with all the conditions, however, he added that this is without prejudice to the result of the EMB CO inspection since the company's ECC was issued by the latter.

Mr. Magallanes said that the problem is the congestion of the Macadam Road as it is being used as the main thoroughfare by the public. Atty. Aquino added that the transport terminal should be functional in order for the community to utilize the road.

Engr. Alvin S. Requimin (MGB MIMAROPA) stated that the company may write to the Provincial LGU or to the DPWH regarding the issue, citing safety concerns as Macadam Road is a mine haul road. He added that if Rakub Road is a barangay road, the barangay can make a resolution and then endorse it to the Sangguniang Bayan, which will then endorse it to the concerned Congressman for possible funding.

The Chairperson stated that for the meantime, the MRFC should not spend more time on the issue as the solution to the problem is not within the control of the MRFC.

#### On the Tugboat Incident

 Mr. Magallanes gave an update on the conducted investigation regarding the incident. The problem, he pointed out, is that the province and municipality have different assessments as to the amount that the company will pay. Atty. Aquino stated that he will seek a meeting with the LGUs to possibly come up with a joint resolution.

#### 4. SEP Clearance of RTNMC for its Expansion

The Chairperson inquired if the matter will be presented during the company presentation. EnP. Janice M. Tupas (RTNMC) replied that they have not prepared a presentation, but on 27 February they had a communication with the PDO of PCSDS and was informed that they will call for a technical conference with RTNMC.

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Ms. Rhoda B. Roque (PCSDS) stated that RTNMC is being required to show proof that they have a SEP Clearance for their expansion. She added that PCSDS has written a letter to RTNMC informing them that they need to secure a SEP clearance for their expansion and that the SEP Clearance issued in 2015 only covers the conversion from AMA to MPSA.

# D. Technical Reports

#### 1. Presentation of Highlights of the 4Q2022 MMT Validation

Engr. Al Janry S. Tuazon presented the findings and recommendations for Rio Tuba Nickel Mining Corporation project during the 1st Quarter 2023 MMT monitoring.

Engr. Requimin requested to look back on the graph of Volume of Silt Removed and noticed that the highest point of the graph is on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter of 2021. The Chairperson asked the company to explain the results of the graph; more specifically, why there is a high volume of silt removed in 2021. EnP. Tupas explained that the company conducted a major desilting and redesigning of the siltation ponds. In explanation to the huge difference of numbers in 2020 and 2021, the company reiterated that in 2021, they installed more desilting pads which gives them access to the center of the ponds, and with that, more silts are retrieved.

Engr. Al Janry S. Tuazon (MGB MIMAROPA) proceeded to present the findings and recommendations for Rio Tuba Nickel Mining Corporation – Gotok Limestone Quarry project on their 4th Quarter AEPEP.

The Chairperson asked why the company generated a high amount of hazwaste compared to the set target. Engr. Tuazon said that this is due to the additional wastes collected due to the pull-out of contractors from their respective areas, which was also the case for solid wastes generated.

### 2. Presentation of highlights of the 1st Quarter 2023 Water, Air and Noise **Monitoring and Sampling**

Ms. Swin R. Tanduyan (EMB MIMAROPA) presented the highlights of the 1st Quarter 2023 Water, Air and Noise Monitoring and Sampling for the Rio Tuba Nickel Mining Corporation Project. Results were within the DENR standards.

The Chairperson pointed out that the presentation of the results of parameters below detection limit has to be fixed/improved and directed the MMT to do so for the next MRFC meeting.

After which, Ms. Tanduyan presented the highlights of the 1st Quarter 2023 Water, Air and Noise Monitoring and Sampling for the Gotok Limestone Quarry Project. Results were within the DENR standards.

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3. Presentation of compliance with the 4Q2022 MMT's field findings and recommendations and presentation of physical and financial accomplishments, including updating and established Funds.

EnP. Tupas presented the company's 2022 AEPEP Accomplishments for the Nickel Mining Project.

- The Chairperson strongly recommended that the company conduct the noise monitoring at fixed times for each station.
- The Chairperson relayed the DENR's request for donations of double cartridge masks for the workers of the Mindoro Oil Spill clean-up.

Engr. Marjorie N. Bacosa (RTNMC) presented the company's 2022 AEPEP Accomplishments for the Gotok Limestone Quarry Project.

#### E. Presentation of recent drone shots/videos of rehabilitation areas

Presented during the company's presentation.

#### F. Other Matters

# 1. Letter of ELAC regarding the investigation on RTNMC's Compliance with the ECC conditions and Contreras' Complaint

Engr. Requimin gave a brief background regarding the matter. The Chairperson asked the company if they are aware of this, to which the company replied in the affirmative. The Chairperson instructed the MSESDD to prepare a complete staff work regarding the complaint, including discussions during the previous MFRC meetings.

#### 2. Land Dispute Update (Nieves Cruz)

Engr. Rogel asked the company if they already had a discussion with the CENRO regarding the issue. Engr. Suguitan replied in the affirmative and further stated that the CENRO will submit a report to the DENR MIMAROPA regarding the matter. The Chairperson instructed the secretariat to write to RED as to what has been the latest development on the investigation on the land dispute of certain Ms. Nieves Cruz within the MPSA of Rio Tuba which was endorsed to the CENRO for discussion with RTNMC.

#### 3. Tugboat Incident

#### 4. Clarification on the SEP Clearance

In view of the letter of PCSDS regarding issues concerning the SEP Clearance issued to them under expansion, RTNMC is requested to give its position paper on the matter for information reference and further action by the MRFC.
