3	Commissioner's Report during the Luzon Summit Ms. Divine Jhonnabelle J. Tamayo, NYC – OCRL Representative	Ms. Tamayo reported the 3-day SK summit held on October 28-30 at Subic, Zambales. The summit was attended by 408 incumbent SK Officials and representatives from Local Youth Development Councils of Luzon. Ms. Tamayo discussed the objectives and evaluation of the program. For the evaluation, the summit received an overall satisfaction rating of 4.64 out of 5 for the Service Quality which covers the organizer and secretariat's responsiveness, reliability, access to facilities, communication, integrity, assurance and outcome while an overall satisfaction of 4.71 out of 5 was given to learning sessions and workshops.

He presented the timeframe of consolidation of report from barangay up to national consolidation leading to the creation of National SK Monitoring Report.

to send invitations a month prior to the event to give them time to prepare and reschedule their activities. Mr. Angeles responded that online submission of reports is currently in the works and ensure that the feedback on the LYDO summit be addressed.

Mr. Randell Dotillos of DILG MIMAROPA reported that they've assisted the PYDO of Palawan in completing their SKPP and LYDO directories. He suggested the other LGUs having similar challenges in data gathering to send request for them to provide assistance.
