This pertains to the previous submitted report dated March 1, 2023 regarding the identified fire prone area within the graduated National Greening Program CY 2017 in Barangay Quezon, Busuanga, Palawan.

Due to the recent incidence of fire, the inspection team that analyzed the proposed fire-prone area in Barangay Quezon determined that its remaining planted Acacia mangium has low survival rate. Thus, the team decided to recommend relocation the identified fireprone area to Sitio Bantad, Barangay San Nicolas, Coron, which is a 2017 NGP site with a total area of 42 hectares and a greater survival rate than the previously selected location.

The selected contractor will establish a 5-meter width by 500-meter-long fire line covering a total of 2500 hectares to protect the remaining plants that have survived this project.

This report will serve a means of verification (MOV) of the office. Attached herewith are geotagged photos and GIS map.

















