A N S W E R

Respondent, unto this Honorable Office, most respectfully states that:

1. On **07 March 2023**, Respondent was informed by DENR-CENRO Socorro, Oriental Mindoro that it had received a copy of this Office's Formal Charge dated 23 January 2023 against him with an order to submit an Answer in writing under oath in not less than three (3) days but not more than ten (10) days from receipt thereof;
2. On **10 March 2023**, Respondent personally received a copy of the said Formal Charge;

(Certified True Copy of the Formal Charge with receiving details is attached hereto and made an integral part hereof as **ANNEX "1"**)
3. In computing a period, the first day shall be excluded and the last day included.¹
Hence, the last day for filling of this Answer is on **20 March 2023**;
4. **Respondent specifically denies the allegations in said Formal Charge;**
5. Lot 1292 located at Maluanluan, Pola, Oriental Mindoro is a public land subject of Residential Free Patent Application. **Prior to its approval as such and/or**

subdivision, it underwent processes in which Respondent is *not a privy* because these are beyond his duties, responsibilities, and authority;

6. On 29 January 2020, survey team led by **Engr. Caren Joy Ordoña** together with **LMO III Delia T. Almarez**, then Chief of Regulation and Permitting Section (RPS), conducted community meeting, ocular inspection, and public survey of the said lot. In a Memorandum prepared and signed by Chief Almarez, it was recommended that **“Public Land Subdivision Plan of Lot 1292, CAD 957-D covered by Survey Order No. 2020-002 be approved leading to the issuance of residential patents.”**² According to Chief Almarez, the basis of such recommendation are the following facts (among others) that she have ascertained:

2. That the said lot in is **actual occupation of 76 residents/occupants** and they agreed to subdivide the lot according to the area they occupied (see attached plan);³

xxx

4. The land is primarily devoted **for residential purposes**;⁴

xxx

6. That the land is **free from claims and conflicts** at the time of inspection and time of actual survey.

xxx

(Certified True Copy of said Memorandum with subject, “Supplemental Report for the Approval of Public Land Subdivision Plan of Lot 1292, CAD-957-D, Maluanluan, Pola, Oriental Mindoro,” is attached hereto and made an integral part hereof as **ANNEX “2”**)

7. Per recommendation of Chief Almarez, the Regional Office approved the Subdivision Plan CSD-4B-003285 with seventy-six (76) lots on 13 February 2020;

(Certified True Copy of the Partial List of Claimants prepared by Barangay Secretary Riechelle V. Peradilla, noted by Barangay Councilor Jonalyn M. Padua, and certified by Barangay Captain Rodante F. Montealegre is attached hereto and made an integral part hereof as **ANNEX “3”**)

8. **From then, Respondent complied dutifully and in good faith with all the orders assigned by Chief Almarez relative to the processing of patent applications;**
9. Respondent was assigned to facilitate the Residential Free Patent Applications covering Lot Nos. 1292-2, 3, 7, 18, and 19 of CSD-4B-003285. **However, Respondent was informed that there were already pre-arranged agreements among the barangay officials, claimants, and Chief Alvarez to streamline the application process;**
10. On 07 July 2020, Chief Almarez together with Respondent and other concerned personnel went to Barangay Maluanluan to formally accept the application of the claimants and conduct geotagging of photos;

11. The questioned Investigation and Ocular Inspection Reports *were all duly accomplished by Chief Almarez* and each application was supported by Joint Affidavit of Disinterested Persons, Certification and *Pagpapatunay* signed by the Barangay Captain. Chief Almarez then ordered Respondent to just attach his signature and take geo-tagged photos to reinforce the respective applications. **As a mere subordinate, his hands are tied. He does not have the capacity to question his Chief's orders, all he can do is to comply thereto and trust her decisions;**

ISSUES

- I. Whether or not Respondent's conduct is prejudicial to the best interest of the service; and
- II. Whether or not Respondent is inefficient and incompetent in the performance of official duties.

AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSES

12. According to the Supreme Court, the quantum of proof in administrative proceedings necessary for a finding of guilt is *substantial evidence* or such relevant evidence as a reasonable mind may accept as adequate to support a conclusion. The burden to establish the charges rests upon the complainant. **The case should be dismissed for lack of merit if the complainant fails to show in a satisfactory manner the facts upon which his accusations are based.** The respondent is not even obliged to prove his exception or defense;⁵
13. **Respectfully, the Formal Charge is unclear and lacking. It neither specify the particular conduct or incompetent performance of Respondent nor the alleged damage to his public office.** It is not even accompanied by certified true copies of the documentary evidence involved specifically the mentioned Investigation Report dated 02 September 2020 and its attachment(s), if any, which are *violations of Rule 5, Section 23 of 2017 Rules on Administrative cases in the Civil Service (2017 RACCS)* more so, *his constitutional right to be informed of the nature and cause of charges against him;*
- I. **Respondent's conduct is not prejudicial to the best interest of service.**
14. In catena of cases, the Supreme Court explained that the latter deals with a demeanor of a public officer which "tarnished the image and integrity of his/her public office";⁶
15. According to the Supreme Court, the following acts or omissions have been treated as conduct prejudicial to the best interest of the service: (a) misappropriation of public funds; (b) abandonment of office; (c) failure to report back to work without prior notice; (d) failure to safe-keep public records and property; (e) making false entries in public documents; (f) falsification of court

orders; (g) a judge's act of brandishing a gun; and (h) threatening the complainants during a traffic altercation;⁷

16. **Respondent has never been involved in any issue similar to the abovementioned.** He is already **sixty-one (61) years old** and has been permanently employed by this Honorable Office **since 1994** as Utility Worker I up to present. Prior thereto, he worked for the same office as Cartographer I **beginning year 1987 – a total of thirty-six (36) years of service – more than half of the life of Respondent:**

II. **Respondent's is not inefficient and incompetent in the performance of his official duties.**

17. There is no particular definition of "inefficiency" and "incompetence" in the Civil Service Law. However, Supreme Court is consistent in attributing such to *poor performance*;⁸

18. **The Individual Performance Commitment and Review (IPCR) of Respondent for the past six (6) years are all "Very Satisfactory" – proofs that he is efficient and competent in the performance of his official duties;**

(Certified True Copy of said Respondent's IPCR from year 2017 to 2022 are attached hereto and made an integral part hereof as **ANNEX "4-A"**, " to **"9-B"**, respectively)

19. Although his designation is Utility Worker I, whose tasks are seemingly irreconcilable with that of a Land Inspector, Respondent was compelled to be deputized. **He accepted the corresponding responsibilities, trusted his Chief, and persevere to help not only his co-workers, but also the applicants in expediting the land registration process.** According to Chief Almarez's comments on Respondent's IPCR Form for the periods of January to December 2020 and July to December 2021 and, he in fact, **accomplished all targets on time**;⁹

20. Further, Respondent's current Chief, LMO III Maria Alva Renelyn A. Culla-Umali, commented on his IPCR Form for the periods of January to June 2022 and July to December 2022 that Respondent:

Work(s) well with his co-employees

xxx

*Willing to offer assistance and advice at any time
to his co-worker.¹⁰*

21. **Hence, it would be the height of injustice to rule that Respondent is inefficient and incompetent despite the consistent "Very Satisfactory" IPCR rating and upstanding comments from his immediate supervisor(s), past and present.**

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, Respondent humbly and respectfully prays that:

- I. This Honorable Office **DISMISS** and/or **RECONSIDER THE FORMAL CHARGE**¹¹ against him for lack of merit and in consideration of the following reasons:
 - a. Respondent did not tarnish the image and integrity of his public office instead, his actions were always done in good faith, under the orders of his Chief, and with the intention to uphold public interest;
 - b. Respondent is not inefficient and incompetent in the performance of his official duties. On the contrary, his IPCR for the past years are proofs that he is efficient and competent;
 - c. Respondent spent more than half of his life working at the DENR, he is nearing compulsory retirement age, and has never been found guilty of any administrative offense related to his official duties. This is the first Formal Charge he faced; and
 - d. Respondent acted without malice, did not take undue advantage of his official position, and did not receive any personal gain or benefit in the performance of his official duties.
- II. As much as the Respondent desires to request for the conduct of Formal Investigation, *unfortunately, he does not have the financial capacity to hire legal services, pay for the travel expenses to attend hearings, and other related fees to fully defend himself during such process. Nonetheless, he would like to humbly ask for this Honorable Office not to overlook the fact that the person who can completely explain what occurred during the Residential Free Patent Application in Maluanluan, Pola and who has the final decision in matters relative thereto, is the then Chief, yet she was neither investigated nor charged;* and
- III. This Honorable Office grant other just and equitable reliefs in the premises.



Pursuant to the 2017 Rules on Administrative Cases in the Civil Service (2017 RACCS), you are hereby formally charged for Conduct Prejudicial to the Best Interest of the Service and Inefficiency and Incompetence in the Performance of Official Duties, committed as follows:

The findings in your Investigation and Ocular Inspection (with geotagged photographs) conducted on July 07, 2020 regarding Residential Free Patents (RFP) covering Lot Nos. 1292-2, 3, 7, 18, and 19, all of Csd-4B-003285, Barangay Maluanluan, Pola, Oriental Mindoro, are in contrast with the Investigation Report dated September 02, 2020 submitted by the PENRO and CENRO Composite Team regarding Lot 1292:

In response to the Show-Cause Memorandum dated June 03, 2022 issued by the undersigned, you submitted a Memorandum dated July 19, 2022 stating among others, that:

- "3.Walang mga improvements o developments ngunit may mga residente ng Barangay Maluanluan na gustong aplayan ang mga lupain na kabilang sa Lot Nos. 1292-7, 18, at 19;
4. Ang mga aplikante ay may itinanim na saging, niyog, at/o mga gulay sa mga lupain na kabilang sa Lot Nos. 2 at 3;

5. Ang lahat ng aplikante ay residente ng Barangay Maluanluan; at

6. Sa kabila ng mga nabanggit, ang bawat aplikasyon ay suportado ng Joint Affidavit of Disinterested Persons, Certification at Pagpapatunay na nilagdaan ng Kapitan" ng Barangay na nagsasaad na ang mga aplikante ay mga okupante o patuloy na umuokupa at lumilining sa mga nsabing lupain sa loob ng partikuar(sic) na panahon.

Ang mga kinauukulang barangay ay may awtoridad na patunayan ang mga kwalipikasyon ng mga residente. Sa kadahilanang ito, at sa aking pagbibigay halaga sa kahit anong uri ng improvements o developments na makikita sa mga nabanggit na lupain, tulad ng paglinang sa mga ito, inilakip ko ang aking lagda sa Investigation and Ocular Inspection Report(s) na may petsang 07 Hulyo 2020.

Wala akong masamang intension at higit sa lahat wala akong natanggap na personal na pakinabang o benepisyo kaugnay ng mga nasabing pangyayari. Ang layunin ko lamang ay matulungan ang mga kinikilalang residente ng Barangay Maluanluan na magkaroon ng sariling lupain at makasunod sa itinakdang oras upang maisakatuparan ang patent target ng aming opisina.

Noong ika-26 ng Oktubre 2021, ipinadala ng DENR-PENRO MIMAROPA sa opisina ng Regional Executive Director ang mga Requests for Revocation of Residential Free Patent.

Batay sa nabanggit, buong kababaang-loob kong hinihiling ang iyong pang-unawa."

However, Section 3 of DAO No. 2010-25¹ explicitly states that:

"Sec. 3. Qualifications. - Applicants for the issuance of a residential free patent shall possess the following qualifications, namely:

XXX

3.2 **Actual occupation, actual residence and continuous possession and occupation of the parcel subject of the application, either by herself or himself or through her or his predecessor-in-interest, under a bona fide claim of acquisition of ownership, for at least ten (10) years prior to the filing of the application.**" (emphases supplied)

Upon evaluation of all the documents submitted, there is a *prima facie* case to formally charge you with Conduct Prejudicial to the Best Interest of the Service and Inefficiency and Incompetence in the Performance of Official Duties under the 2017 RACCS.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, you are hereby ordered **TO SUBMIT YOUR ANSWER IN WRITING UNDER OATH IN NOT LESS THAN THREE (3) DAYS BUT NOT MORE THAN TEN (10) DAYS FROM RECEIPT HEREOF**. Indicate in your Answer whether or not you elect to have a formal investigation. You are advised that you may opt to be assisted by a counsel.

1. That the above-cited lot, as per records is covered with Cadastral Survey containing an area of 13,859 square meters surveyed for Celeste A. Pranada, one among the actual occupants on the said lot as per actual inspection;
2. That the said lot in is actual occupation of 76 residents occupants and they agreed to subdivide the lot according to the area they occupied (see attached plan;
3. That the lot is within the Alienable and Disposable area/zone under LC Map No. 215 certified on March 31, 1924 by the then Director of the Forestry;
