TASK FORCE OIL SPILL

SITUATION

- Reported sightings of oil spill having the stretch of half kilometer to one (1) kilometer along the coast of Barangay Casian, Taytay, Palawan from Taytay MDRRMO.
- At around 10:00 o'clock in the morning the dispatched Barangay officials reported the oil spill to Barangay Captain Norbert Lim. Accordingly, the area covered by oil slick is quite large as it continues to reach other portions of nearby beaches and residents reported its foul odor. It was confirmed by the Coast Guard Substation (CGSS) Taytay who conducted on site verification at Sitio Amianan in Casian. On the same day, another oil spill sighting was reported at Icadambanauan Island in Biton.

Environmental greetings

This pertains to the recent Naujan Oil Spill incident due to the sunken MT Princess Empress resulting in the spillage of approximately 800,000 liters of industrialized fuel oil at Oriental Mindoro on March 1, 2023. Currently, the University of the Philippines Marine Science Institute forecasts that the oil spill will reach Cuyo Island and get closer to the northern Palawan in about a week.

In this regard, we would like to request your assistance to mobilize our concerned partner agencies to intensify monitoring on the possible spread of oil slick within the waters of Taytay and take appropriate and necessary action pertaining on the matter. Kindly coordinate with this Office on any report for our further coordinated actions.


