















#### **PURPOSE**

- Approve AB & SB
- Promulgate Resolutions
- Hold fund-raising activities





# **Grant of Honorarium to SK Officials**

Can the SK allocate less than 25% for honorarium?



Can the SK allocate less than 25% for honorarium?

Answer: YES. The 25% is the maximum percentage allowable for the allocation of honoraria. Thus, it is possible to allocate less than 25%.



Is the SK Chairperson included in the budgeting for the honorarium for SK Officials?




Is the SK Chairperson included in the budgeting for the honorarium for SK Officials?

Answer: NO. Per Sec. 3.1.2 of LBC 148 SK chairperson shall no longer be entitled to receive any honorarium from the regular SK funds (except those funded by higher-level LGUs)

# **Grant of Honorarium to SK Officials**



### Requirements



Grant of honorarium to SK Officials shall be:

- Included in the CBYDP and ABYIP
- Subject to the SKplanning & budgetingprocess



- Shall be subject to pertinent budgeting, accounting & auditing laws, rules, & regulations
- Shall be monitored by the Budget Monitoring Officer



There are vacant positions in your council. Do you still need to budget their honorarium?



Answer: YES. Per Sec. 3.1.8 of LBC No. 148, the total honorarium to be included in the SK AB shall cover SK Officials, whether the SK position is filled or unfilled.

# Additional Honorarium from the LGUs

#### Requirements

- Request of SK Officials, through a letter by the SK Chairperson
- Fulfillment of the requirements set forth and agreed upon by the LGU and SK in the MOA or contract

Roles of SK

Allocate an amount for PS which should not be more than 25% of the

SK funds

Provide an honorarium in the SK Annual Budget which cover SK Officials

#### Roles of the LGU

The grant of ASH shall be taken up as **financial subsidy** to SK in the books of account of the LGU

The grant of ASH shall be included in the **Annual**Investment Program of the LGUs

**Observe funding priorities** in the grant of ASH to SK Chairperson & the elected & appointed members

Establish a mechanism or system to ensure that the Honorarium of the SK Officials and SK Chairperson **shall not exceed** the honorarium of SK Chairperson and Sangguinang Barangay

Ensure that the **grant must not significantly affect** the capability to allocate adequate funds for the delivery of basic services/facilities & implement development projects
